### Game facts: Zalgiris Kaunas

Eleven different players have appeared in the Zalgiris starting lineup so far this season; no one has started in every game.

Arturas Milaknis has made at least 1 three-pointer in 13 straight EuroLeague games.

Brandon Davies has scored at least 10 points in nine of his last 10 EuroLeague games.

Edgaras Ulanovas has made 10 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Davies ranks fifth in the EuroLeague in scoring this season with 14.0 points per game. He ranks seventh in average performance index rating with 16.6.

Marius Grigonis is third in the EuroLeague in free throw accuracy this season at 94.38%.

Paulius Jankunas is second in EuroLeague history with 1,733 career rebounds. Real Madrid's Felipe Reyes is first with 1,780.

Jankunas ranks fourth on the all-time charts with 2,966 points. Real Madrid's Felipe Reyes enters this round in third place with 2,992 points.

Jankunas needs 1 offensive rebound to become just the third player in competition history with 500 offensive rebounds.

Jankunas is 4 blocked shots away from 100 for his career.

No player has started more games in EuroLeague history than Jankunas, who has 259 career starts.

Edgaras Ulanovas needs 9 points to reach 1,000 for his career. Brandon Davies needs 2 assists to reach 100 in EuroLeague games.

During this series, Arturas Milaknis has moved past his coach Sarunas Jasikevicius and into 14th place on the all-time list with 317 three-point shots made. Marcus Brown is 13th with 327 triples in his career.

Coach Zeljko Obradovic has used 12 different starters this season. No player has started every game.

Ali Muhammed has made at least 1 triple in 10 consecutive EuroLeague appearances.

Luigi Datome has made 21 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Datome has made multiple three-pointers in four straight EuroLeague games.

Melih Mahmutoglu has made 14 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Kostas Sloukas has made at least 1 three-pointer in seven of his last eight EuroLeague appearances.

Sloukas has made 13 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Sloukas has posted a performance index rating in double figures in seven of his last eight appearances.

Erick Green has made 11 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Jan Vesely is fourth in the EuroLeague this season with an average PIR of 18.3 per game.

Vesely is fourth in the EuroLeague in steals with 1.4 per game this season.

Marko Guduric is tied for third in the EuroLeague in three-point accuracy this season at 50.0%. Ali Muhammed is fifth at 49.2%.

Jan Vesely is seventh in EuroLeague history with 399 offensive rebounds; Kerem Gonlum is sixth with 421.

Vesely needs 3 rebounds to reach 1,000 for his EuroLeague career. He will become the 14th player to reach that milestone.

Luigi Datome ranks fifth all-time in free throw accuracy at 91.09%.

Nikola Kalinic needs 3 three-pointers to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.

Erick Green needs 1 point to reach 1,000 for his EuroLeague career.

Ali Muhammed needs 1 steal to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.



Fenerbahce is 13-6 against Zalgiris in games played this century. In Game 1 of this series, Fenerbahce triumphed 76-43 with Nikola Kalinic scoring 16 points. Zalgiris held on for an 80-82 victory in Game 2 with Edgaras Ulanovas collecting 20 points and 7 rebounds.

This season Fenerbahce swept the regular season series, first winning 75-82 in Kaunas in Round 3 behind 20 points from Kostas Sloukas and then triumphing 78-61 in Istanbul in Round 18 with Sloukas and Melih Mahmutoglu scoring 14 points apiece.

Fenerbahce and Zalgiris met in the 2018 EuroLeague Final Four semifinals last May with Fenerbahce coming out on top 76-67 behind 19 points in 12 minutes from Ali Muhammed. Luigi Datome had 16 points and a career-high 3 blocks.

Zalgiris swept the then-called Ulker Genclik in the best-of-three eighthfinals playoffs back in 1999. Zalgiris went on to win its only EuroLeague title that season.

In Game 1, Fenerbahce allowed 43 points, the lowest it ever allowed in a EuroLeague game. For Zalgiris, 43 points were its lowest single-game total this century.

Zalgiris head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius played for Fenerbahce during the 2010-11 season and helped the team win the Turkish League and Cup double.

Jasikevicius played at Panathinaikos for four seasons under current Fenerbahce head coach Zeljko Obradovic, from 2007 to 2010, and then in the 2011-12 season. The two won the 2009 EuroLeague title together.

Zalgiris guard Nate Wolters and Fenerbahce swingman Marko Guduric were teammates at Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade during the 2016-17 season.

Joffrey Lauvergne of Fenerbahce and Leo Westermann of Zalgiris were teammates at Partizan Belgrade for a season and a half, from 2012 to 2014. They have also been teammates on the French national team and together they won bronze medals at EuroBasket 2015.

Ahmet Duverioglu set a new career high with 7 rebounds in Game 1.

Kostas Sloukas delivered a career-high 11 assists in Fenerbahce's 82-68 win over Zalgiris in October 2016. He matched that tally twice during last season's playoff series.

Fenerbahce playmaker Ali Muhammed posted his career high in rebounds with 9 playing for ASVEL Villeurbanne against Zalgiris in October 2009.

Nicolo Melli set a career-high with 5 steals in the EuroLeague Final Four semifinal win over Zalgiris last May in Belgrade.

Luigi Datome matched his career-high with 3 blocks in EuroLeague Final Four semifinal win over Zalgiris last May in Belgrade.


Nate Wolters scored a career-high 23 points in the Round 3 loss this season. Wolters also had a career-best 3 steals playing for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade against Fenerbahce in December 2016.

Jan Vesely, who entered the season as a career 56.2% free throw shooter, is 101 for 125 (80.8%) from the foul line this season.

Panathinaikos has started 13 different players this season. Nick Calathes is the only player to start every game. Nick Calathes has dished at least 5 assists in 18 of his last 19 EuroLeague games.

Calathes has scored at least 10 points in nine of his last 10 EuroLeague games.

DeShaun Thomas has scored in double figures in 12 of his last 13 EuroLeague appearances.

Thomas has made at least 1 three-pointer in seven straight EuroLeague appearances.

Georgios Papagiannis has blocked at least 1 shot in seven of his last eight games.

Sean Kilpatrick has made at least 1 three-pointer in six straight EuroLeague appearances.

Nick Calathes leads the league in assists this season with 8.7 per game and leads the season charts in steals with 1.7 per game.

Georgios Papagiannis is second in the EuroLeague in two-point accuracy this season at 72.73%. Thanasis Antetokounmpo is fifth at 68.75%.

Calathes is tied for second in the playoffs this season with 5.5 assists per game.

Nick Calathes became only the second player this century – and first since Nikola Vujcic 12 years ago – to record a triple-double. In Round 30 he tallied 11 points, 18 assists and 12 rebounds.

Calathes has moved into fourth place all-time time with 263 steals; Pablo Prigioni is third with 322.

Calathes is in seventh place all-time with 998 assists; Sergio Llull is sixth all-time with 1,024 steals and counting. Lukas Lekavicius needs 12 assists to reach 300 for his EuroLeague career.

Walter Tavares has posted a PIR of 13 or more in eight of his last nine EuroLeague appearances.
Facundo Campazzo has made 12 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.
Rudy Fernandez has made at least 1 three-pointer in six consecutive EuroLeague games.
Klemen Prepelic has made at least 1 three-pointer in six of his last seven EuroLeague games.
Walter Tavares leads the league in blocked shots this season with 1.6 per game.
Tavares is fifth in the league in offensive rebounds with 2.2 per contest.
Tavares leads the EuroLeague in two-point accuracy this season at 78.57%.
Facundo Campazzo is third in the league this season with 1.6 steals per game.
Jaycee Carroll leads the EuroLeague in free throw accuracy this season with 95.74%. Sergio Llull is second at 95.45%.
Campazzo leads the playoffs with 7.5 assists and 4.0 steals per game.
Campazzo is second in the playoffs this season with an average PIR 22.0
Tavares is second in the playoffs with 1.5 blocks per game. He is third with 7.0 rebounds per game.
Jeffery Taylor is tied for second in the playoffs with 6 three-point shots made.
Felipe Reyes is the EuroLeague career rebounding king with 1,780 boards.
Reves is the EuroLeague career leader in games played with 343.
Reyes is ranked third all-time in EuroLeague scoring with 2,992 points.
Reyes ranks third all-time with 959 two-point shots made. Georgios Printezis of Olympiacos Piraeus is second with 966.
Sergio Llull ranks sixth all-time with 2,834 points. Georgios Printezis is fifth with 2,914.
Llull ranks sixth on the all-time charts with 1,024 assists. Sergio Rodriguez of CSKA Moscow is fifth with 1,080 and counting.
Llull ranks fourth in EuroLeague history with 429 three-pointers made. Vassilis Spanoulis is third with 450 and counting.
Lull is third in all-time playoff three-pointers with 62. Olympiacos guard Vassilis Spanoulis is second with 63.
Rudy Fernandez is in sixth place all-time in steals with 260. Gianluca Basile is fourth with 261.
Fernandez is sixth all-time with 392 three-pointers made. Gianluca Basile is fifth with 421.
Walter Tavares is the all-time EuroLeague leader in two-point accuracy at 73.7%.
Jaycee Carroll is sixth all-time in free throw accuracy at 91.0%.
Carroll is 11th all-time with 355 three-point shots made. His former teammate Sergio Rodriguez of CSKA Moscow is 10th with 371 and counting.



In their clashes since 2000, Madrid holds a 16-10 edge over Panathinaikos and has won seven in a row. In Game 1, Real Madrid scored last 9 points to pull out a 75-72 victory. Jeffrey Taylor scored 13 points and Fabien Causeur 12, while Walter Tavares collected 8 points and 8 rebounds for the winners. Nick Calathes scored 17 in defeat.

Madrid led for all but the first 90 seconds of its 78-63 Game 2 win. Facundo Campazzo posted 13 points and 9 assists plus career-highs of 7 rebounds and 5 steals in less than 23 minutes for the winners.

Madrid swept Panathinaikos in the regular season. In Round 13, Madrid won 89-68 as Fabien Causeur led Madrid scorers with 14 points. In Round 29 in Athens, Madrid rallied from 18 points down to win 73-74 on a buzzer-beating three-pointer from Rudy Fernandez. In that game, Walter Tavares had 14 points and a EuroLeague club record 16 rebounds.

Last season, Madrid and Panathinaikos faced off in the EuroLeague Playoffs. The Greens started rolling in Game 1 with a 95-67 triumph, but it was all Madrid from there to take the series 3-1 en route to the title in Belgrade. In Game 1 of that playoff series, Nick Calathes dished 16 assists to break the EuroLeague Playoffs record. In Round 25 last season, Madrid beat Panathinaikos 92-75 at home as Fabien Causeur scored 26 points and was MVP of the Round with a performance index rating of 29.

Injured Madrid big man Ognjen Kuzmic made his EuroLeague debut in 2015-16 for Panathinaikos. He was a teammate of current Panathinaikos players Nikos Pappas, James Gist and Nick Calathes.

Kuzmic had career-highs of 15 rebounds and 6 offensive rebounds for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade against Panathinaikos in October 2016.

Madrid's Sergio Llull posted a career-high 30 points when Madrid edged Panathinaikos 87-84 in November 2016. Panathinaikos forward Thanasis Antetokounmpo posted his career high in rebounds with 7 against Madrid last March.

Panathinaikos forward Deshaun Thomas matched his career high in steals with 3 in Round 13. Walter Tavares had a career-high and Madrid club record 16 rebounds, including a career-best 6 offensive rebounds, in the Round 29 win over Panathinaikos.

CSKA leads the series 28-9 this century. In Game 2, Baskonia registered a 68-78 win to tie the series. It was Baskonia's first win over CSKA in Moscow since the 2005 Final Four – a run of 15 consecutive defeats. Vincent Poirier earned MVP of Game 2 honors after collecting 14 points, 15 rebounds

and a career-high 4 steals for a PIR of 32.

In Game 1, CSKA beat Baskonia 94-68 behind 19 points from Sergio Rodriguez.

In Round 30 in the first week of April, CSKA rallied from a double-digit second-half deficit to beat Baskonia 82-78 with Will Clyburn collecting 16 points and 6 rebounds. In Round 11 in Vitoria-Gasteiz, Baskonia edged CSKA 76-73 with Vincent Poirier posting 18 points and 8 rebounds.

Baskonia beat CSKA in Moscow in the 2005 semifinals in what is regarded as one of the biggest upsets in Final Four history; Baskonia won 78-85 after CSKA had reached that game with a 19-1 record in the EuroLeague. Arvydas Macijauskas led Baskonia with 23 points.

CSKA and Baskonia faced each other in the 2008 EuroLeague semifinals in Madrid. CSKA rallied from a 6-point halftime deficit to beat Baskonia 79-83. Ramunas Siskauskas and David Andersen led the way with 16 points apiece. In the 2017 EuroLeague Playoffs, CSKA swept Baskonia capped by an 88-90 win in Game 3 in Vitoria-Gasteiz behind 21 points from Cory Higgins.

CSKA ousted Baskonia twice more in the EuroLeague Playoffs, in 2010 and 2013, both times winning the series 3-1. Baskonia set a club record with 10 blocked shots against CSKA in March 2015.

CSKA set its EuroLeague club record with 10 blocked shots against Baskonia in January 2015.

CSKA scored its EuroLeague club record of 112 points against Baskonia in November 2016.

CSKA guard Nando De Colo and Baskonia forward Toko Shengelia were teammates at Valencia Basket during the 2009-10 season and won the 2010 EuroCup title together that season.

Baskonia big man Vincent Poirier was a teammate of De Colo on the French national team at EuroBasket 2017. Baskonia sharpshooter Matt Janning and CSKA guard Daniel Hackett were teammates at Montepaschi Siena during the 2012-13 season.

CSKA forward Andrey Vorontsevich had 13 rebounds – 10 of them defensive, both career-bests, against Baskonia in March 2015.

Vorontsevich had a career-high 4 blocks against Baskonia in January 2015.

CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov matched his career-best with 10 rebounds against Baskonia in November 2016. Jayson Granger had his only EuroLeague double-double with 20 points and 10 assists playing for Unicaja Malaga against CSKA in a 95-85 road loss in November 2014.


Toko Shengelia posted his career high in performance index rating with 33, along with a career-best 6 offensive rebounds, in a loss against CSKA in December of last season.

Barcelona holds a 10-6 record in games between these teams this century. Efes beat Barcelona 75-68 in Game 1 with Vasilije Micic starring with a playoff career-high 21 points on 4-of-5 three-point shooting plus 7 assists. His career-high PIR of 30 earned him MVP of the Round honors. Barcelona pulled out a 72-74 victory in Game 2 of the series with Adam Hanga posting 17 points. These two teams split home wins this regular season. Barcelona registered an 80-65 victory in Round 15 as Pierre Oriola scored 14 points. In Round 25, Efes blasted Barcelona 92-70 behind 37 points from Shane Larkin. Barcelona matched its club best in the EuroLeague in points and set a club record in three-point shots made with 19 when it beat Efes 83-107 in Istanbul in March of last season. Efes recorded its team record in two-point shots made with 32 against Barcelona in October 2002. Efes set its playoff record with 12 three-pointers in its Game 1 victory. Efes forward Adrien Moerman played at Barcelona last season. He played under Coach Svetislav Pesic and was a teammate of most of the current Barcelona players. Barcelona point guard Thomas Heurtel played for Efes from 2015 to 2017; he was a teammate of Dogus Balbay and Bryant Dunston during his time there. Efes center Tibor Pleiss played at Barcelona during the 2014-15 season and was a teammate of Ante Tomic. Pleiss was a teammate of Heurtel for two seasons at Baskonia, from 2012 to 2014. Pleiss was also a teammate of Adam Hanga at Baskonia in the 2013-14 season. Barcelona's Kevin Pangos was a teammate of Efes point guard Vasilije Micic at Zalgiris Kaunas last season. They helped the team reach the 2018 Final Four. Vasilije Micic set a career-high in performance index rating with 30 in Game 1. Barcelona's Jaka Blazic and Hanga were teammates with the Efes backcourt duo of Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin at Baskonia during the 2016-17 season. Barcelona center Ante Tomic was a long-time teammate of Efes guard Krunoslav Simon, first with KK Zagreb where they both grew up, and with the Croatian national team, too. Shane Larkin set career-highs with 37 points and PIR 43, latter of which is also Efes club record, in Round 25 win over Barcelona, Larkin earned MVP of the Round honors for that performance. Larkin posted his career high in steals with 4 playing for KIROLBET Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz against Barcelona in January 2017. Barcelona forward Adam Hanga posted his EuroLeague career high in scoring with 20 for Baskonia against Efes in February 2017. Hanga set his career-high with 11 rebounds in Game 1. Pierre Oriola set his career high in assists with 5 in Game 2. Tomic set his EuroLeague career high and a Barcelona club record in index rating with 40 and pulled down a careerhigh 15 rebounds in Barcelona's 84-89 road win over Efes in February 2014. Tomic posted a career-high and matched a club record with 11 two-point shots made in that game, too. Efes big man Brock Motum posted his EuroLeague career-highs in scoring (26) and index rating (26) playing for Zalgiris Kaunas against Barcelona in November 2017. Victor Claver matched his career-high with 3 steals against Efes in November of last season.
