



#### Roster

Coach Ataman has used 12 different players as starters this season. No player has started every game. Chris Singleton has never sat out a EuroLeague game. He has made 161 appearances in his fifth season in the competition, which is the fifth-longest streak in the EuroLeague all-time. Streaks Shane Larkin has made multiple threes in 11 of his last 12 games. Larkin has scored in double figures in 12 straight and 21 of his last 22 games. Larkin has posted double-digit PIRs in 11 of his last 12 games. Larkin has collected at least 1 steal in 11 of his last 12 games. Larkin has made 19 consecutive free throws. Rodrigue Beaubois has made at least 1 three-point shot in 15 straight games. Vasilije Micic has posted double-digit PIRs in eight of his last nine games. Micic has hit at least 1 three-pointer in eight of his last nine games. Rankings Shane Larkin leads the league this season in average PIR with 25.8 per game. Larkin leads the EuroLeague in scoring this season with 22.2 points per game. Larkin ranks third this season in three-point accuracy at 50.9%. Larkin leads the league this season with 3.5 three-point shots made per game. Vasilije Micic ranks fifth this season with 5.8 assists per game. **Records/Milestones** Shane Larkin set the EuroLeague all-time single-game scoring record with 49 points in a Round 11 win over FC Bayern Munich. In that game, he also tied the competition record with 10 three-pointers made. Larkin also knocked down record-tying 10 triples again last week in Round 28, when he also scored 40 points, becoming the first player this century to score 40 or more points twice in his career. Bryant Dunston ranks second all-time with 242 blocks. He trails only Fran Vazquez (249). Dunston ranks ninth with 403 career offensive rebounds. Othello Hunter of Maccabi FOX Tel Aviv is eighth with 418 and counting. Tibor Pleiss is sixth all-time with 175 blocked shots. Ioannis Bourousis is fifth with 194. Dogus Balbay needs 1 more steal to reach 100 for his career. James Anderson needs 3 rebounds to reach 500 for his career.



### Game facts: Valencia Basket

#### Roster

Head coach Jaume Ponsarnau has used 14 different starters this season. Valencia has 19 registered players, so there will be several scratches every week. Jordan Loyd is sidelined with a broken foot. Sam Van Rossom has returned to action, but missed the last six rounds with an injury. Streaks Bojan Dubljevic has posted double-digit PIRs in seven of his last eight appearances. Dubljevic has made 15 consecutive free throws.

Sam Van Rossom has made 14 consecutive free throws.

Bojan Dubljevic ranks seventh this season with 6.5 rebounds and sixth with 2.4 offensive rebounds per game. Records/Milestones

Anadolu Efes Istanbul vs. Valencia Basket

• Efes has a 4-3 edge in games against Valencia in the EuroLeague this century. Efes beat Valencia 78-83 in Round 3 as Krunoslav Simon scored 19 points and Vasilije Micic had 15 points and 12 assists. That was the first time a road team won a game between these two teams.

· Valencia scored its most points in a EuroLeague game with 107 and set a club record with 31 two-pointers made in 107-103 overtime win over Efes Pilsen in February 2004.

• Brock Motum joined Valencia this summer after spending two seasons with Efes and helping the team reach the Turkish Airlines EuroLeague Championship Game last spring.

· Efes center Tibor Pleiss spent the 2017-18 season with Valencia. He was a teammate there of eight current

Valencia players, including Fernando San Emeterio, with whom he also played at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz from 2012 to 2014.

• Efes big man Chris Singleton posted his career-high in rebounds with 13 playing for Panathinaikos Athens against Valencia in December 2017.

• Valencia forward Alberto Abalde posted his career-high in assists with 8 against Efes in February 2018. Abalde also posted his career-high in steals with 3 against Efes in Round 3 loss this season.

· Efes guard Shane Larkin matched his career-high with 4 steals in a Round 3 win over Valencia.

· Efes forward Alec Peters set his career-high in index rating with 25 in Round 3 against Valencia.

Luca Vildoza has made 30 consecutive free throws. Rankings Tornike Shengelia ranks sixth this season in average PIR with 18.5 per game. Shengelia ranks seventh this season with 15.9 points per game. Pierria Henry leads the league lead in steals this season with 1.6 per game. Records/Milestones Zoran Dragic needs 8 three-point shots to reach 100 for his career. #### Game notes:

Maccabi FOX Tel Aviv vs. KIROLBET Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz

• Baskonia leads its head-to-head series against Maccabi 16-13 this century, but Maccabi beat Baskonia 83-113 in Round 8. Maccabi set a club record with 17 three-pointers and its 113 points tied Maccabi's scoring record in a road game and were the most points a road team has scored in a single-game in almost 12 years. It was also the first time in EuroLeague history that Baskonia lost at home by 30 points.


• Maccabi defeated Baskonia in consecutive Final Fours in 2005 and 2006 - the former of which came in the championship game in Moscow, where Maccabi successfully defended its title by beating Baskonia 90-78. Final Four MVP and current Zalgiris coach Sarunas Jasikevicius led the winners with 22 points.

• Maccabi established a club and Final Four record 9 blocks against Baskonia in an 85-70 victory in the 2006 semifinals. Maccabi has matched the club record six times since


