



Andrey Vorontsevich suffered an ankle injury during warmups in Round 21 and is expected to miss several games. Streaks

Mike James has made at least 1 three-point shot in 15 straight games.

James has scored in double figures in each of his last 20 games.

Shane Larkin set the EuroLeague all-time single-game scoring record with 49 points in a Round 11 win over FC Bayern Munich. In
that game, he also tied the competition record with 10 three-pointers made.
Bryant Dunston ranks second all-time with 242 blocks. He trails only Fran Vazquez (249).
Dunston is eighth all-time with 403 career offensive rebounds. Kerem Gonlum is seventh with 421.
Tibor Pleiss ranks seventh all-time with 173 blocked shots. Stephane Lasme is sixth with 174.
Rodrigue Beaubois ranks 14th all-time in free throw accuracy at 89.38%.
Dogus Balbay needs 5 more steals to reach 100 for his career.
Chris Singleton needs 33 points to reach 1,500 for his career.



#### Game notes:

CSKA Moscow vs. Anadolu Efes Istanbul

• CSKA has a 19-3 record against Efes this century and has won their last 10 meetings. In Round 15, Mike James hit a game-winner with 17 seconds to go to lift CSKA to an 80-81 win in Istanbul. James earned MVP of the Round honors with a PIR of 36; he scored 28 points on a near-perfect shooting night, making 5 of 5 two-pointers and 5 of 7 triples. He also led CSKA with 6 rebounds and added 4 assists.

 $\cdot$  Efes has not beaten CSKA in the EuroLeague this century outside of Istanbul.

• CSKA outlasted Efes 83-91 to win its eighth European crown in the EuroLeague championship game last May. Final Four MVP Will Clyburn scored 20 points as CSKA's scoring co-leader in that game, while Shane Larkin made history for Efes with 29 points, which was the most in the championship game since the turn of the century.

• CSKA and Efes faced each other in the 1999 and 2006 EuroLeague playoffs, then played as a best-of-three series. Efes swept CSKA in 1999 and CSKA did the same to Efes in 2006 and advanced to lift its first EuroLeague trophy in 35 years.

· CSKA has made a club-record 18 three-point shots twice, both times in home wins over Efes. The first was in a 90-68 win in November of 2008 and it happened again in a 110-79 win in January 2018.

Efes center Chris Singleton and CSKA guard Mike James were teammates at Panathinaikos from 2016 to 2018.
 Efes forward Alec Peters arrived from CSKA this summer, where he won the EuroLeague title in his rookie 2018-19 season.

· CSKA forward Will Clyburn was a teammate of current Efes players James Anderson and Adrien Moerman at Darussafaka Istanbul during the 2016-17 season.

· CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov was a teammate of Efes guard Krunoslav Simon at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2014-15 campaign.

• CSKA center Kyle Hines and his Efes counterpart Tibor Pleiss were EuroLeague rookies together during the 2010-11 season with Brose Bamberg.

Big men Tibor Pleiss of Efes and Johannes Voigtmann of CSKA have been teammates on the German national team.
 Johannes Voigtmann of CSKA was a teammate of Efes guards Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz. Voigtmann and Beaubois were teammates for two seasons, from 2016 to 2018; Larkin was there with them in the 2016-17 campaign.

• Last season in Round 5, while playing for AX Armani Exchange Milan, CSKA guard Mike James hit a three-pointer with a second left to lift Milan to an 81-80 victory over Efes.

· Injured CSKA forward Will Clyburn posted his career-high 7 offensive rebounds against Efes in 102-84 home win over Efes last season. CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov set his career-high with 6 steals in that game.

 $\cdot$  Kyle Hines matched his career-high with 4 blocks playing for Olympiacos against Efes in April 2013.

· CSKA forward Semen Antonov posted a career-best 16 points against Efes while playing for Nizhny Novgorod in November 2014.

· Efes center Bryant Dunston set a career-high with 8 offensive rebounds playing for Olympiacos Piraeus against CSKA in February 2015.

Zalgiris Kaunas vs. Olympiacos Piraeus

· Olympiacos holds a 13-10 edge over Zalgiris in EuroLeague games this century. In Round 8, Olympiacos beat Zalgiris 83-74 behind 16 points and 7 assists from Vassilis Spanoulis. Zalgiris has won seven of their last nine head-to-head games.

 $\cdot$  Zalgiris has won its last four home games against Olympiacos.

• The Lithuanian champs ousted Olympiacos from the 2018 EuroLeague Playoffs with a 3-1 series win without the home-court advantage.

· Zalgiris and Olympiacos faced each other in the 1999 Final Four in Munich, Germany. It was the first-ever official clash between these two sides. Zalgiris downed Olympiacos 87-71 in the semifinals behind 19 points from Anthony Bowie and went on to lift its first – and to date only – EuroLeague trophy.

· Zalgiris head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius was a teammate at Panathinaikos Athens of Olympiacos guard Vassilis Spanoulis for three seasons, from 2007 to 2010. The two won the 2009 EuroLeague title together.

· Zalgiris big man Zach LeDay made his EuroLeague debut with Olympiacos last season.

• Marius Grigonis set his career-high with 19 points in an 83-75 win over Olympiacos in Round 11 last season. • Zalgiris forward Edgaras Ulanovas earned MVP of the Round honors for Game 4 of the 2018 EuroLeague Playoffs with 20 points, 9 rebounds and a performance index rating of 27.

· Zalgiris guard Lukas Lekavicius had a EuroLeague career-high 8 assists playing for Zalgiris Kaunas against Olympiacos in December 2016.

· Olympiacos guard Taylor Rochestie had a career-high 4 steals playing for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade against Zalgiris in January 2018.
