Game notes:

CSKA Moscow vs. AX Armani Exchange Milan


- This rivalry goes back more than half a century - dating back to the 1966 EuroLeague semifinal. It has often been one-sided. Milan won eight of the first 11 games between the sides, but CSKA has enjoyed clear dominance over Milan in recent years, winning the last eight meetings between the teams.
- In the first-ever Final Four back in 1966, CSKA and Milan met in one of the semifinals played in Bologna, Italy. Milan beat CSKA 57-68 thanks to 20 points from future Hall of Famer Bill Bradley and went on to win its first European crown.
- Coach Messina had two highly-successful stints coaching CSKA. In his first four-year period in the Russian capital, Messina guided CSKA to two EuroLeague titles (2006 and 2008) and reached two more championship games (2007 and 2009). In his second stint, he reached the Final Four twice (2013 and 2014).
- During his years at CSKA, Messina coached three players from the current CSKA roster: Andrey Vorontsevich, Kyle Hines and Nikita Kurbanov.
- CSKA guard Mike James played with Milan last season. He was the 2018-19 Alphonso Ford Top Scorer Trophy winner averaging 19.8 points per game and was a teammate of the majority of current Milan players.
- Milan point guard Sergio Rodriguez spent the last two seasons with CSKA and helped it win the 2019 EuroLeague title. He played under head coach Dimitris Itoudis and was a teammate of the majority of the current CSKA squad.
- Vladimir Micov played for CSKA Moscow for two seasons from 2012 to 2014, during which he reached a pair of EuroLeague Final Fours and won a pair of VTB United League titles. He was a teammate there of current CSKA forward Andrey Vorontsevich for both years and with Kyle Hines during his second season with the club.
- CSKA guard Daniel Hackett played for Milan for a season and a half. Hackett joined Milan in December 2013 and stayed there until the summer of 2015. He helped it reach the 2014 EuroLeague Playoffs.
- Hackett and Milan's Andrea Cinciarini have been teammates on the Italian national team.
- Hackett was a teammate of Milan's Amedeo Della Valle, Paul Biligha and Jeff Brooks on the Italian national team at the 2019 World Cup.
- Hackett played under Milan head coach Ettore Messina on the Italian national team in 2016.
- Milan guard Michael Roll was a teammate of CSKA guard Mike James at Laboral Kutxa, now called KIROLBET Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz, briefly at the end of the 2015-16 season.
- Roll matched his career-high with 7 assists playing for Maccabi FOX Tel Aviv against CSKA in October 2018.
- Sergio Rodriguez posted a career-high with 13 assists playing for Real Madrid against CSKA in January 2016.
- Milan center Kaleb Tarczewski had a career-high 17 points and a career-best PIR of 25 against CSKA in January of last season.
- Milan forward Jeff Brooks set his new career-high with 13 rebounds against CSKA last season.
- Milan forward Aaron White set a career-high with 3 blocks playing for Zalgiris Kaunas against CSKA in January 2019.
- Milan big man Luis Scola matched his career-best with 10 defensive rebounds playing for Tau Ceramica against CSKA in November 2004. He also had a career-high 7 assists against CSKA in March 2004.

- Maccabi matched a club record in EuroLeague play this century with 9 blocks against Efes in November 2017.
- Efes big man Bryant Dunston and CSKA center Othello Hunter were teammates at Olympiacos Piraeus during the 2014-15 season.
- Maccabi's Ioannis Sfairopoulos coached Efes center Bryant Dunston at Olympiacos Piraeus during the 2014-15 season. Dunston earned EuroLeague Best Defender honors that season.
- Maccabi guard Scottie Wilbekin was a teammate of Efes players James Anderson and Adrien Moerman at Darussafaka Istanbul two seasons ago.
- Efes forward Alec Peters and Maccabi center Othello Hunter were teammates at CSKA Moscow last season. They won the 2019 EuroLeague title together.

- Barcelona has gotten the better of Olympiacos this century, winning 16 of their last 25 games.
- The last time they played in Barcelona, in Round 13 of last season, Olympiacos took home a 60-69 win behind 18 points plus 14 rebounds, including 7 offensive boards, from Nikola Milutinov. He accumulated a PIR 36 and earned MVP of the Round honors.
- Olympiacos won its first EuroLeague title by beating Barcelona 73-58 in the 1997 championship game in Rome as Final Four MVP David Rivers scored 26 points.
- Barcelona defeated Olympiacos in the 2010 EuroLeague championship game in Paris 86-68 thanks to 21 points from Final Four MVP Juan Carlos Navarro.
- Olympiacos forward Georgios Printezis hit the game-winning and series-clinching three-pointer in Game 4 of the 2015 EuroLeague Playoffs against Barcelona. He was also MVP of the Round for Game 2 of that series after posting 22 points, 9 rebounds and a PIR of 34 in a road win.
- Olympiacos forward Sasha Vezenkov spent three seasons with Barcelona, from 2015 to 2018, where he was a teammate of much of the current Barcelona roster. He played under Coach Svetislav Pesic in the 2017-18 campaign.
