

Roster

Coach Sarunas Jasikevicius has used 11 different starters this season. Only Edgaras Ulanovas has started in each game. Arturas Milaknis has 161 consecutive appearances in the competition, the longest active streak and fourth-longest this century. Marius Grigonis is expected to miss three months after undergoing foot surgery last week.

Streaks

Jock Landale has scored in double figures in six of his last seven games. Landale has pulled down multiple offensive rebounds in seven consecutive games. Marius Grigonis has made at least 1 three-pointer in 10 of his last 11 appearances dating back to last season.

Records/Milestones

Paulius Jankunas ranks second all-time with 1,765 rebounds. Real Madrid's Felipe Reyes is first with 1,782. Jankunas is the EuroLeague all-time leader with 1,260 defensive rebounds. Jankunas is third with 505 offensive rebounds for his career; CSKA Moscow's Kyle Hines is second with 534 and counting. Jankunas ranks fourth all-time with 3,010 points. Jankunas ranks fifth all-time with 3,670 performance index rating points. Jankunas is in fourth place all-time with 954 two-pointers made; Felipe Reyes is third with 961 and counting. Jankunas moved into fifth all-time with 691 free throws made. Jankunas is 4 blocked shots away from 100 for his career. No player has started more games than Jankunas, who has 262 career starts. Arturas Milaknis is in 13th place on the all-time list with 337 three-point shots made. Trajan Langdon is 12th with 339 triples for his career. Marius Grigonis ranks fourth all-time in free throw accuracy at 91.53%.

Coach Ataman has used 11 different players in his starting lineups so far this season. Only Vasilije Micic has started every game.

Efes has 16 players registered to play this season, so at least four must sit every game.

Chris Singleton has never sat out a EuroLeague game. He has 146 appearances in his fifth season in the competition.

Bryant Dunston has missed the last six games with an injury.

Shane Larkin has made at least 1 three-point shot in 26 straight games.

Larkin has scored in double figures in nine straight and 20 of his last 21 games.

Shane Larkin set the all-time single-game EuroLeague scoring record with 49 points in a Round 11 win over FC Bayern Munich. In that same game, he also tied the competition record with 10 three-pointers made.

Bryant Dunston ranks second all-time with 242 blocks. He trails only Fran Vazquez (249).

Dunston is eighth all-time with 403 career offensive rebounds. Jan Vesely of Fenerbahce is seventh with 417 and counting.

Tibor Pleiss is ranked seventh all-time with 168 blocked shots. Stephane Lasme is sixth with 174.

Chris Singleton needs 2 blocks to reach 100 for his career.

Singleton needs 6 three-point shots to reach 200 for his career.

Vasilije Micic needs 1 more steal to reach 100 for his career.

Game notes:

Zalgiris Kaunas vs. Anadolu Efes Istanbul

- Zalgiris holds 9-5 edged in games against Efes this century. The road team has won seven of the last eight games between these two teams; they split road wins last season.
- Efes point guard Vasilije Micic played for Zalgiris during the 2017-18 season. He played under head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius and was a teammate of much of the current Zalgiris roster.
- Efes forward James Anderson made his EuroLeague debut with Zalgiris during the 2014-15 campaign. Anderson was the competition's seventh-best scorer that season with 14.5 points per contest and was a teammate of three current Zalgiris players: Paulius Jankunas, Arturas Milaknis and Edgaras Ulanovas.
- Anderson and Panathinaikos guard Lukas Lekavicius were teammates at Zalgiris Kaunas during the 2014-15 season.
- Efes swingman Krunoslav Simon accumulated a career-high index rating of 35 playing for Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar against Zalgiris in January 2014.
- The last time these two teams faced each other in January 2019 in Kaunas, Efes forward Adrien Moerman matched his career-high with 23 points in a 58-79 road win.
- Moerman posted a career-high 5 steals playing for Darussafaka Istanbul against Zalgiris in November 2016.
- Efes center Bryant Dunston matched his career-high in blocks with 5 against Zalgiris in November 2017.
- Zalgiris forward Edgaras Ulanovas scored a career-high 22 points and posted a career-best index rating of 32 in a 91-83 home win against Efes in November 2017.
- Zalgiris sharpshooter K.C. Rivers posted his career-high in assists with 6 playing for Real Madrid against Efes in November 2014.

DeShaun Thomas and Nick Calathes have started every game for Panathinaikos so far this season.

Kostas Papadakis is set to make his EuroLeague debut.

Panathinaikos is carrying 14 players on its active roster, so at least two players must sit out every game.

Nick Calathes has started 123 consecutive games in which he appeared. The last time he came off the bench was in January 2016.

Rankings

Nick Calathes ranks fifth season in average PIR with 20.0 per game.

Calathes leads the league this season with 9.2 assists per game.

Records/Milestones

Last season in Round 30, Nick Calathes became the second player this century – and first since Nikola Vujcic more than a decade prior – to record a triple-double. He tallied 11 points, 18 assists and 12 rebounds in a win over Buducnost VOLI Podgorica.

Calathes set single-season records last season with 286 total assists and with an average of 8.7 assists per game.

In Round 12, Tyrese Rice scored 41 points, tied for second-most in a EuroLeague game this century. In that game, he set a club record in points (41) and three-pointers made (8).

Calathes ranks fourth all-time time with 283 steals; Pablo Prigioni is third with 322.



- Kaunas, Lithuania, is the hometown of both Kemzura and Khimki head coach Rimas Kurtinaitis. The two were teammates at Rytas Vilnius during the 1998-99 season.
- Khimki forward Janis Timma played for Olympiacos during the first part of last season before being loaned to Khimki. He was a teammate there of Nikola Milutinov, Kostas Papanikolaou, Aleksej Pokusevski, Georgios Printezis, Vassilis Spanoulis and Sasha Vezenkov. Current Olympiacos head coach Kestutis Kemzura was an assistant on that team.
- Olympiacos forward Sasha Vezenkov tied his career-high with 3 steals playing for FC Barcelona against Khimki in December 2017.
