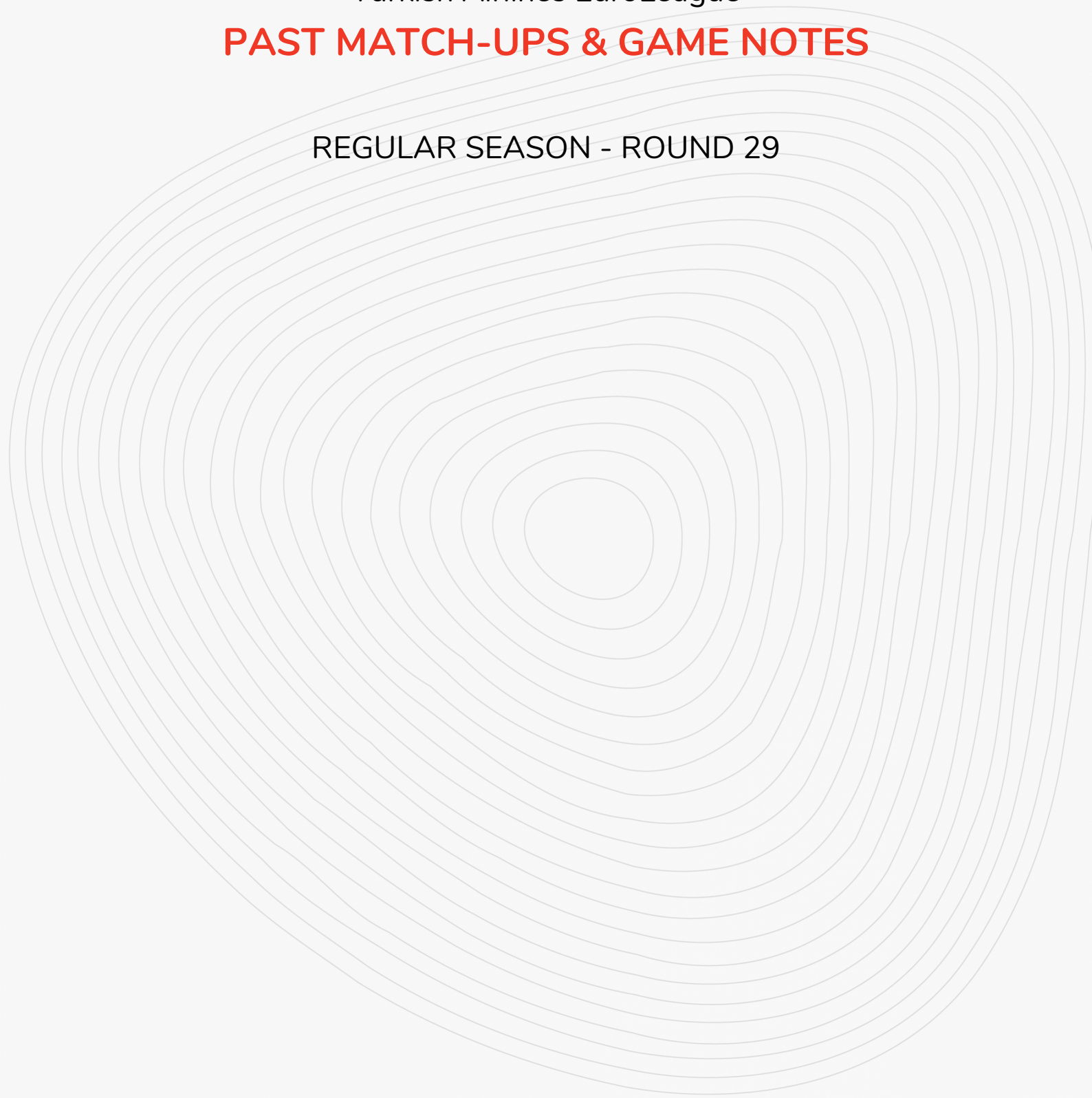


















Game facts: Panathinaikos OPAP Athens

Panathinaikos has started 13 different players this season. Nick Calathes is the only player to start every game. Evangelos Sakellariou is set to make his EuroLeague debut.

Nick Calathes has collected at least 1 steal in 14 of his last 15 games.

Calathes has dished at least 9 assists in six straight games and at least 5 assists in 15 consecutive games.

Calathes has scored at least 10 points in six straight and nine of his last 10 games.

Calathes has posted a performance index rating in double figures in 17 of his last 18 games.

DeShaun Thomas has scored in double figures in nine straight EuroLeague games.

Georgios Papagiannis has blocked at least 1 shot in four straight and five of the six games he's played since moving into the starting lineup.

Nick Calathes leads the league in assists this season with 8.8 per game.

Calathes tops the season-long charts in steals with 1.8 per game.

Georgios Papagiannis is second in the EuroLeague in two-points accuracy this season at 75.0%. Thanasis

Antetokounmpo is third at 72.88%.

Calathes is fifth all-time with 258 steals, Gianluca Basile is fourth with 261.

Calathes ranks eighth all-time with 964 assists. Theo Papaloukas is seventh with 977.

James Gist needs 24 more points to reach 2,000 for his career.

Keith Langford needs 2 more offensive rebounds to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.

Lukas Lekavicius needs 13 assists to reach 300 for his career.

Game facts: Real Madrid

There have been 13 different starters for Madrid this season. No player has started every game.

Sergio Llull has made 34 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague action.

Llull has made at least 1 three-pointer in 11 of his last EuroLeague 12 games.

Jaycee Carroll has made at least 1 three-pointer in five of his last six EuroLeague games.

Trey Thompkins has made 10 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague action.

Thompkins has made at least 1 three-pointer in four straight and six of his last seven EuroLeague games.

Anthony Randolph has made at least 1 three-pointer in 16 of his last 17 EuroLeague games.

Randolph has scored at least 10 points and posted a double-figure PIR in seven of his last eight games.

Gustavo Ayon is tied for fifth in the league this season in rebounding with 6.3 per game.

Facundo Campazzo is third in the league this season with 1.5 steals per game.

Walter Tavares leads the league in blocked shots this season with 1.7 per game.

Sergio Llull leads the EuroLeague in free throw accuracy this season with 97.62% and Jaycee Carroll is second at 97.22%

Tavares leads the EuroLeague in two-point accuracy this season at 75.49%.

Felipe Reyes is the EuroLeague career rebounding king with 1,777 boards.

Reyes passed Juan Carlos Navarro in Round 27 for the EuroLeague games-played record with 342.

Reyes is ranked third all-time in EuroLeague scoring with 2,990 points.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 958 two-point shots made. Ante Tomic of FC Barcelona Lassa is first with 1,031 and counting.

Sergio Llull ranks sixth all-time with 2,822 points. Georgios Printezis is fifth with 2,896 and counting.

Llull ranks sixth on the all-time charts with 1,019 assists. Sergio Rodriguez of CSKA Moscow is fifth with 1,067 and counting.

Llull ranks fourth in EuroLeague history with 426 three-pointers made. Vassilis Spanoulis is third with 450 and counting.

Rudy Fernandez is in sixth place all-time in steals with 257. Nick Calathes is fifth with 258 and counting. Gianluca Basile is fourth with 261.

Fernandez is sixth all-time with 386 three-pointers made. Gianluca Basile is fifth with 421.

Walter Tavares is the all-time EuroLeague leader in two-point accuracy at 71.70%.

Jaycee Carroll is fifth all-time in free throw accuracy at 91.01%.

Carroll is 11th all-time with 351 three-point shots made. His former teammate Sergio Rodriguez of CSKA Moscow is 10th with 361 and counting.

Game notes:

In their clashes since 2000, Madrid holds a 13-10 edge over Panathinaikos and has won four in a row. Madrid beat Panathinaikos 89-68 in Round 13 as Fabien Causeur led Madrid scorers with 14 points.

Last season, Madrid and Panathinaikos faced off in the EuroLeague Playoffs. The Greens started rolling in Game 1 with a 95-67 triumph, but it was all Madrid from there to take the series 3-1 en route to the title in Belgrade.

In Game 1 of that playoff series, Nick Calathes dished a career-high 16 assists to break the EuroLeague Playoffs record.

In Round 25 last season, Madrid beat Panathinaikos 92-75 at home as Fabien Causeur scored 26 points and was MVP of the Round with a performance index rating of 29.

Injured Madrid big man Ognjen Kuzmic made his EuroLeague debut in 2015-16 for Panathinaikos. He was a teammate of current Panathinaikos players Nikos Pappas, James Gist and Nick Calathes.



Kuzmic had career-highs of 15 rebounds and 6 offensive rebounds for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade vs. Panathinaikos in October 2016.














Madrid's Sergio Llull posted a career-high 30 points when Madrid edged Panathinaikos 87-84 in November 2016.















Panathinaikos forward Thanasis Antetokounmpo posted his career high in rebounds with 7 against Madrid last March.

Madrid center Walter Tavares matched his career high in scoring with 14 points against Panathinaikos last March.

Panathinaikos forward Deshaun Thomas matched his career high in steals with 3 in Round 13.



In that Round 6 clash, Bayern set its club record in a EuroLeague game for the biggest win (46 points), most points scored (116), assists (28), three-point shots made (18), three-point accuracy (69.2%) and total performance index rating (156). It was the most points any team has scored in a EuroLeague game in more than a decade. It was also the eighth-highest team PIR ever in a game.

Their only previous two meetings were in the 2018 EuroCup Semifinals, with Darussafaka sweeping the best-of-three series. Darussafaka won Game 1 on a buzzer-beating triple by Stanton Kidd, 76-74, and won the series after Game 2 in Munich, which it took 83-87 behind 41 points by Scottie Wilbekin.

Olympiacos holds a 12-9 edge over Zalgiris in EuroLeague games, but Zalgiris has won six of the last seven head-to-head games. In Round 11, Zalgiris downed Olympiacos 83-75 behind a career-high 19 points from Marius Grigonis. The Lithuanian champs swept Olympiacos from the EuroLeague Playoffs last season with a 3-1 series win without the home-court advantage.

Zalgiris edged Olympiacos 78-87 in overtime in Game 1 of last season's playoffs and then clinched the series at home by winning 80-60 in Game 3 and 101-91 in Game 4. Zalgiris center Brandon Davies averaged a performance index rating of 19.8 along with 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.3 blocks in that playoff series, which helped him win MVP of April honors.

Zalgiris and Olympiacos faced each other in the 1999 Final Four in Munich, Germany. It was the first-ever official clash between these two sides. Zalgiris downed Olympiacos 87-71 in the semifinals behind 19 points from Anthony Bowie and went on to lift its first – and to date only – EuroLeague trophy.

Olympiacos head coach David Blatt was an assistant coach on the Maccabi Tel Aviv squad that won the EuroLeague in 2003-04 with Sarunas Jasikevicius as its point guard.

Zalgiris point guard Leo Westermann and Olympiacos center Nikola Milutinov were teammates at Partizan Belgrade for two seasons, from 2012 to 2014.

Georgios Bogris was a teammate of current Zalgiris head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius at Panathinaikos for two seasons, from 2009 to 2011. They won the 2011 EuroLeague title together.















Olympiacos forward Axel Toupane played for Zalgiris last season. He played under Coach Saunas Jasikevicius and was a teammate of most of the current Zalgiris squad.















Westermann and Toupane have been teammates on the French national team.

Zalgiris forward Edgaras Ulanovas earned MVP of the Round honors for Game 4 of the EuroLeague playoffs last season with 20 points, 9 rebounds and a performance index rating of 27.


Brandon Davies had career-highs of 6 offensive rebounds and 3 blocks in a 78-87 overtime win over Olympiacos in Game 1 of the EuroLeague Playoffs last season. He also had a career-best 4 steals in the regular season finale against Olympiacos last season.

Tibor Pleiss ranks ninth all-time with 158 blocked shots. He needs 3 more to catch Victor Khryapa for eighth place.

Brock Motum needs 3 more three-pointers to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.

Vasilije Micic needs 19 assists to reach 400 for his career

Game notes:

This is the seventh consecutive season these two teams meet in the Turkish Airlines EuroLeague. Efes holds a 9-8 edge in that time. Efes downed Baskonia 96-85 in Round 10, behind 16 points and 6 assists from Vasilije Micic and 16 points from Brock Motum.

Baskonia head coach Velimir Perasovic had two stints with Efes. He first coached Efes in the 2010-11 season and then again six years later when he guided the team to the 2017 EuroLeague Playoffs. Perasovic was on the Efes bench in the first 12 EuroLeague games last season and his last game was an 81-82 home loss against Baskonia. During his second stint with Efes, Perasovic coached current Efes players Dogus Balbay, Bryant Dunston, Brock Motum, Onuralp Bitim and Krunoslav Simon.

Efes assistant coach Tomislav Mijatovic worked under Perasovic on multiple occasions, including both of Perasovic's stints at Efes and previously for two seasons at Cibona Zagreb from 2008 to 2010.

Baskonia point guard Jayson Granger played at Efes for two seasons, from 2015 to 2017. He was a teammate there of Balbay and Dunston.

Baskonia guard Matt Janning played at Anadolu Efes Istanbul during the 2014-15 season. He was a teammate of Balbay.

Efes center Tibor Pleiss spent two seasons with Baskonia, from 2012 to 2014. He was a teammate of Ilimane Diop. The Efes backcourt duo of Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin both played at Baskonia. They were there together during the 2016-17 season and Beaubois played for Baskonia last season; he has a teammate of much of the Baskonia roster. Larkin was a teammate of Diop, Tornike Shengelia, Johannes Voigtmann and Tadas Sedekersis. Efes center Tibor Pleiss was a teammate of Baskonia point guard Marcelinho Huertas at FC Barcelona Lassa during the 2014-15 season.

Pleiss and Baskonia big man Johannes Voigtmann have been teammates on the German national team.

Baskonia big man Vincent Poirier had 16 points, 12 rebounds and career-bests of 5 blocks and a PIR 35 in an 81-82 road win at Efes in December 2017. He won his first MVP of the Round honor for his performance.

Efes guard Dogus Balbay posted a career-high 7 rebounds against Baskonia in January 2014.

Bryant Dunston recorded a career-high 3 steals for Olympiacos against Baskonia in October 2014 and matched that playing for Efes against Baskonia in December of 2015.

Dunston blocked a career-best 5 shots against Baskonia in February 2017, which he has matched twice since then.

Baskonia's Johannes Voigtmann matched his career high with 13 rebounds against Efes in February 2017.

Jayson Granger matched his career high in assists with 11 against Efes in Round 30 last season.

Rodrigue Beaubois matched his career high in assists with 6 in Round 10.

Matt Janning matched his career high in steals with 3 in Round 10.
