
















No player has started every EuroLeague game for Efes this season. Adrian Moerman has started all but one game. Adrien Moerman has posted a performance index rating in double figures in 11 straight games. Rodrigue Beaubois has made 19 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games. Shane Larkin has hit at least 1 three-point shot in six of his last seven games. Larkin has scored and recorded a performance index rating in double-digit figures in each of his last five EuroLeague games. Larkin has collected at least 1 steal in five straight EuroLeague games. Adrien Moerman is fifth in the league this season in rebounding with 6.5 per game. Vasilije Micic ranks third in the league in assists this season with 5.2 per game. Bryant Dunston is fourth in the league this season with 1.1 blocks per game. Bryant Dunston is second in EuroLeague history with 217 blocked shots. He trails only Fran Vazquez and his 249 rejections. Dunston ranks ninth all-time with 369 career offensive rebounds. Mirsad Turkcan is eighth with 385. Tibor Pleiss ranks ninth all-time with 157 blocked shots. He needs 4 more to catch Victor Khryapa for eighth place. Brock Motum needs 4 more three-pointers to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career. Motum needs 1 more rebound to reach 300 for his career.

Coach Itoudis has used 12 different players in CSKA's starting lineups this season; no player has started in every EuroLeague game.

Will Clyburn has recorded a performance index rating in double figures in 21 of his last 22 EuroLeague games.

De Colo has made 28 straight free throws in EuroLeague games.

Cory Higgins ranks second in the league in scoring this season with 15.0 points per game. Nando De Colo is third with 14.8.

Sergio Rodriguez is tied for fifth in the league in assists this season with 5.0 per game.

Nando De Colo ranks third in free-throw accuracy this season with 96.0%

Higgins leads the league in three-point accuracy this season at 53.85% and Nikita Kurbanov is fifth at 50.0%.

De Colo is the EuroLeague career leader in free-throw accuracy at 93.92%.

Kyle Hines ranks fourth all-time with 202 blocked shots. Maccabi FOX Tel Aviv big man Alex Tyus is third with 207 and counting.

Hines is third in EuroLeague history with 493 offensive rebounds.

Hines is 11th in competition history with 1,108 rebounds. Mike Batiste is 10th with 1,117.

Sergio Rodriguez ranks fifth on the EuroLeague all-time charts with 1,059 assists for his career; Milos Teodosic is fourth with 1,126 career assists.

Rodriguez is 10th all-time with 360 three-point shots made; Dimitris Diamantidis is ninth with 372.

Daniel Hackett needs 3 assists to reach 500 for his EuroLeague career.

Game notes:

CSKA has a 16-3 record against Efes this century and has won their last seven meetings, including a 102-84 victory in Round 14 behind 24 points plus 11 rebounds from Will Clyburn and 21 points plus 6 assists from Nando De Colo. CSKA and Efes faced each other in the 1999 and 2006 EuroLeague playoffs, then played as a best-of-three series. Efes swept CSKA in 1999 and CSKA did the same to Efes in 2006 and advanced to lift its first EuroLeague trophy in 35 years.

CSKA has made a club-record 18 three-point shots twice, both times in home wins over Efes. The first was in a 90-68 win in November of 2008 and it happened again in a 110-79 win in January 2018.

CSKA guard Nando De Colo was the MVP for Top 16 Round 3 in the 2014-15 season after leading CSKA to a 69-78 triumph at Efes with 22 points on 12-of-13 free throw shooting for a PIR of 34.

Efes big man Bryant Dunston and CSKA center Othello Hunter were teammates at Olympiacos Piraeus during the 2014-15 season.

Hunter had career-best 5 steals playing for Real Madrid against Efes in Round 15 of the 2016-17 season.

CSKA forward Will Clyburn was a teammate of current Efes players James Anderson and Adrien Moerman at Darussafaka Istanbul during the 2016-17 season.

Clyburn posted his career-high 7 offensive rebounds in Round 14 victory over Efes.

CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov was a teammate of Efes guard Krunoslav Simon at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar in the 2014-15 campaign.

CSKA center Kyle Hines and his Efes counterpart Tibor Pleiss were EuroLeague rookies together during the 2010-11 season with Brose Bamberg.

CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov set his career high with 6 steals in the Round 14 victory.

CSKA guard Daniel Hackett matched his personal best with 3 steals playing for Milan against Efes in March 2014

Kyle Hines matched his career-high with 4 blocks playing for Olympiacos against Efes in April 2013.

Nando De Colo marched his career-high with 4 steals against Efes in January 2015.















CSKA forward Semen Antonov posted a career-best 16 points against Efes while playing for Nizhny Novgorod in November 2014.

CSKA guard Sergio Rodriguez set a career-high with 6 steals playing for Estudiantes against Efes in December 2004.

Paulius Jankunas set his career-high with 12 defensive rebounds against Maccabi in January 2015.


Deon Thompson matched his career-high in performance index rating with 25 playing for ALBA Berlin against Maccabi in December 2012.

Game notes:

Madrid has a nearly unblemished record against Milan, winning 12 of their last 13 meetings, including the last 10 in a row. Madrid is also perfect 6-0 against Milan on its home floor this century.

In Round 2, Madrid rallied from a 15-point deficit to beat Milan 85-91. Anthony Randolph paced the winners with 25 points and 11 rebounds; his PIR of 33 earned him co-MVP of the Round honors.

In 1964, Real Madrid and Simmenthal Milano faced each other in the two-game semifinals. Madrid bounced back from a 5-point loss in Game 1 to beat Milan 101-78 at Fronton Fiesta Alegre in the Spanish capital. Emiliano Rodriguez scored 31 points for Madrid and Clifford Luyk added 28. Madrid went on to win its first continental title. In the 1967 European Cup final played in Madrid - under a Final Four format for just the second time, and for the last until the format became the standard in 1988, Real Madrid downed Simmenthal Milan 91-83 behind 29 points from Emiliano Rodriguez.

Madrid and Milan met in the 1984 Cup Winners' Cup title game played in Ostend, Belgium. It came down to the final seconds, in which Brian Jackson drew a foul and sank both free throws to lift Madrid past Simac Milan 82-81. Jackson was the top scorer with 27 points.

Milan's Mike James and Madrid's Fabien Causeur were teammates at Baskonia for a season and a half, from 2014 to 2016. They helped the team reach the 2016 EuroLeague Final Four together.

Milan center Alen Omic and Madrid swingman Klemen Prepelic were teammates at Union Olimpija Ljubljana in the 2012-13 and 2014-15 seasons. They have also been teammates on the Slovenian national team.

Omic had a career-best index rating of 30 playing for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade against Real Madrid in March of last season. He scored a career-high 25 points on 11-of-13 two-point shooting and pulled down 10 rebounds for the second double-double of his EuroLeague career.

Anthony Randolph pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds in Madrid's 90-101 win in Milan in October 2016.

Curtis Jerrells posted his career highs in index rating (31) and total rebounds (8) playing for UNICS Kazan against Madrid in November of 2014.

Ognjen Kuzmic had a career-high 3 blocks against Milan while playing for Crvena Zvezda in March 2017.

Milan guard Mike James posted 27 points, shooting a perfect 6-for-6 from three-point range, playing for Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz against Madrid in April 2016. No player has hit as many three-pointers without a miss since then.

Milan guard Nemanja Nedovic matched his career-high with 3 steals against Madrid in Round 2 this season.

Milan center Arturas Gudaitis posted career-highs of 20 points and 4 blocks against Madrid in October of last season.

Facundo Campazzo posted his career high in index rating with 32 when these teams met in Round 2.

Trey Thompkins matched his career-high with 15 total rebounds, all defensive, playing for Nizhny Novgorod against Milan in January 2015.
