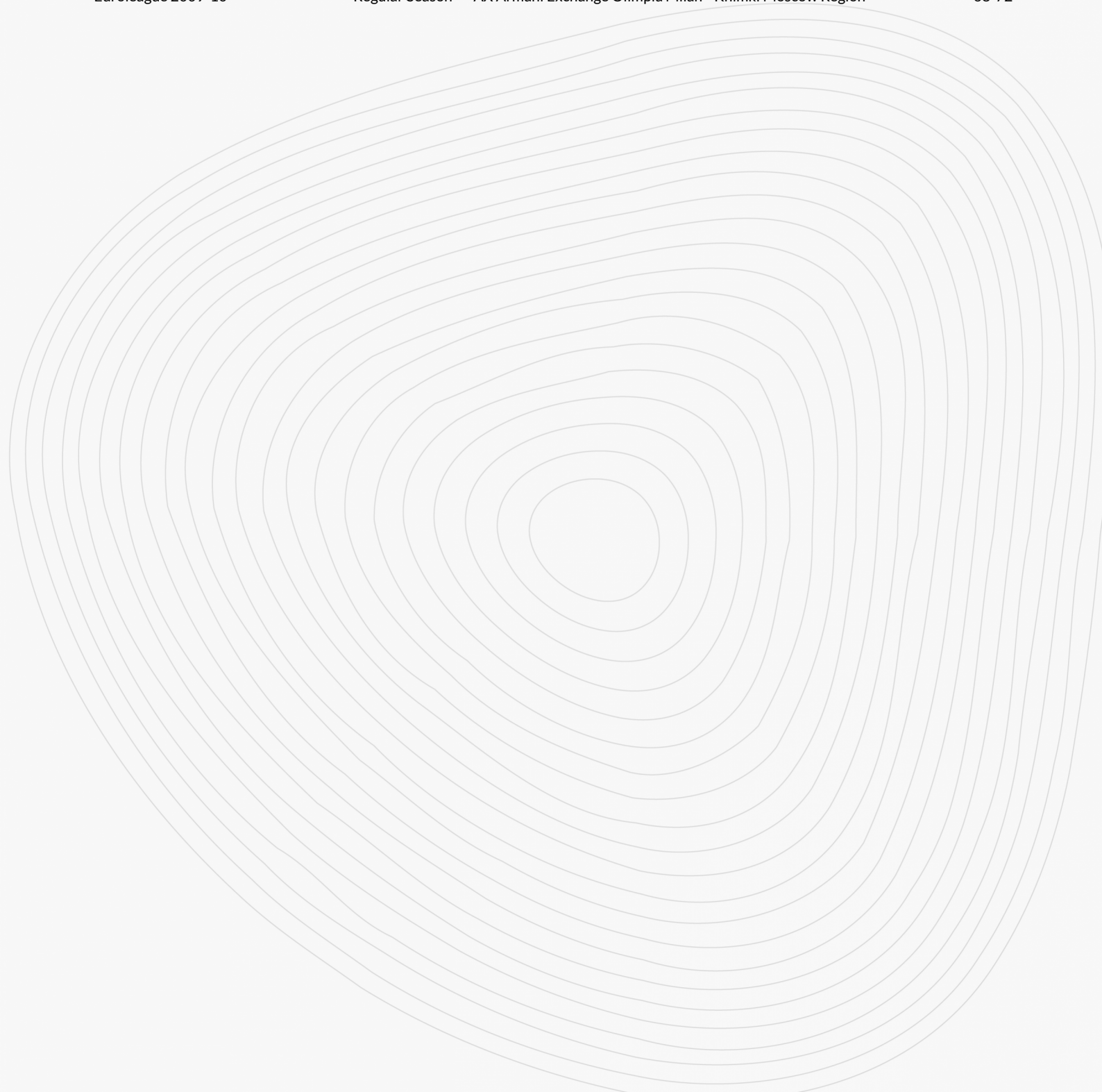

Khimki has used 11 different players in its starting lineups this season; Dee Bost is the only player to have started every EuroLeague game for Khimki.

Alexey Shved, who has been sidelined with a broken finger since November, is expected to play.

Dmitrii Kadoshnikov is in line to make his EuroLeague debut.

Jordan Mickey has scored in double figures in six straight and 16 of his last 17 EuroLeague games.

Tony Crocker has made 13 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague action.

Alexey Shved has made at least 1 three-pointer in 28 straight EuroLeague appearances.

Shved has scored at least 13 points in each of his last 42 EuroLeague games.

Shved has dished at least 4 assists in 18 straight EuroLeague appearances.

Stefan Markovic has made at least 1 three-point shot in nine of his last 10 EuroLeague games.

Alexey Shved's 25.3 points per game and average performance index rating of 25.9 per game are both highest in the league, however, he does not have enough appearances this season to qualify for the leaders' board.

Jordan Mickey ranks fifth in the league in scoring this season with 14.5 points per game and is tied for fifth in the league with 1.0 blocks per game.

Tony Crocker is fifth in the league in free throw accuracy this season at 91.9%.

Anthony Gill is third in the EuroLeague this season in two-point accuracy at 70.83%.

Shved set EuroLeague single-season records last season with 740 points scored and 107 three-pointers made.

Sergey Monia is nearing the 1,000-point milestone for his EuroLeague career. He enters this game with 967.

Mike James and Vladimir Micov have started every EuroLeague game for Milan this season.

Mike James has scored in double figures in each of his last 30 EuroLeague games and had a performance index rating in double figures in 23 of his last 24 games.

James has made at least 1 three-pointer in 26 of his last 27 EuroLeague games.

James has delivered at least 5 assists in each of his last 24 appearances dating back to last season's playoffs.

James has collected at least 1 steal in nine of his last 10 EuroLeague games.

Mindaugas Kuzminskas has made 15 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Nemanja Nedovic has scored in double figures in five of his last six EuroLeague appearances.

Mike James leads the league in scoring with 20.1 points per game. He also leads the EuroLeague in average PIR with 21.4 per game

James is second in the league in assists this season with 7.0 per game.

James is tied for fifth this season with 1.4 steals per game.

Dairis Bertans ranks first in the EuroLeague in three-point accuracy at 53.6%.

James Nunnally leads the all-time EuroLeague charts with 50.91% career three-point accuracy.

Injured center Arturas Gudaitis ranks fifth in the league this season in average PIR at 18.7 per game.

Gudaitis ranks third in the league in rebounding with 7.1 per game and second in offensive rebounding with 3.3 per game

Gudaitis is tied for fifth this season with 1.0 blocks per game.

Vladimir Micov needs 1 offensive rebound to reach 100 for his career.

Kaleb Tarczewski needs 2 offensive rebounds to reach 100 for his career.

Game notes:

Milan edged Khimki 81-80 on Mike James's free throws with 3.3 seconds remaining in Round 4 this season. James led Milan with 25 points and 8 assists in the victory. Jordan Mickey had career-highs of 26 points and a performance index rating of 32 for Khimki.

Khimki guard Charles Jenkins played for Milan during the 2015-16 season and was a teammate there of guard Andrea Cinciarini.

Milan's Mindaugas Kuzminskas and Nemanja Nedovic were teammates of Khimki guard Stefan Markovic at Unicaja Malaga during the 2015-16 season. Kuzminskas and Markovic also played there the previous season.

Markovic and Nedovic have been teammates on the Serbian national team. They won silver medals together at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.















Khimki forward Petr Gubanov and Milan guard Curtis Jerrells were teammates at UNICS Kazan during the 2014-15 season.















Alexey Shved earned MVP honors after scoring 29 points and posting a performance index rating of 35 in a 71-77 road win over Milan in Round 11 of last season.

Milan swingman James Nunnally posted his career high in index rating with 27 for playing Fenerbahce Istanbul against Khimki in November 2017.

Khimki guard Stefan Markovic had 3 steals, which is tied for his career-high, playing for Unicaja Malaga against Milan in March 2015.

Coach Zeljko Obradovic has used 11 different starters this season. No player has started every game.

Kostas Sloukas has made 22 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague action.

Jan Vesely, who entered the season as a career 56.2% free throw shooter, is 80 for 97 (82.5%) from the foul line this season.

Vesely has posted a performance index rating in double figures in 19 of his last 20 appearances.

Jan Vesely is second in the EuroLeague with an average PIR of 20.8 per game.

Vesely is second in the EuroLeague in steals with 1.7 per game this season.

Kostas Sloukas is fourth in the league in free throw accuracy this season at 93.2%.

Luigi Datome ranks seventh all-time in free throw accuracy at 90.46%.

Kostas Sloukas needs 12 points to reach 1,000 EuroLeague points in a Fenerbahçe uniform.

Jan Vesely is seventh in EuroLeague history with 393 offensive rebounds; Kerem Gonlum is sixth with 421.

Vesely needs 28 rebounds to reach 1,000 for his EuroLeague career. He will become the 14th player to reach that milestone.



Game facts: Anadolu Efes Istanbul

No player has started every EuroLeague game for Efes this season. Adrian Moerman has started all but one game.

Adrien Moerman has made 15 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Moerman has posted a performance index rating in double figures in eight straight games.

Tibor Pleiss has made 21 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Rodrigue Beaubois has made 18 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Vasilije Micic has made at least 1 three-pointer in 13 of his last 14 EuroLeague appearances.

Shane Larkin has made 13 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.

Adrien Moerman is fifth in the league this season in rebounding with 6.3 per game and tied for fifth with 1.4 steals per game.

Vasilije Micic ranks third in the league in assists this season with 5.3 per game.

Bryant Dunston is fourth in the league this season with 1.0 blocks per game.

Tibor Pleiss ranks second in the league this season in two-point accuracy at 71.7%.

Bryant Dunston is second in EuroLeague history with 212 blocked shots. He trails only Fran Vazquez and his 249 rejections.

Dunston ranks ninth all-time with 365 career offensive rebounds. Mirsad Turkcan is eighth with 385.

Tibor Pleiss ranks ninth all-time with 156 blocked shots. He needs 5 more to catch Victor Khryapa for eighth place.

Brock Motum needs 4 more three-pointers to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.

Motum needs 4 more rebounds to reach 300 for his career.

Game notes:

This Istanbul derby has been dominated by Fenerbahce with a 9-2 edge in their in their brief EuroLeague history together dating back to 2014. Fenerbahce has won all of its five home game against Efes.

Efes won the clash between these teams in Round 4, 89-83, as Rodrigue Beaubois scored 17 points and Adrien Moerman collected 15 points plus 10 rebounds.

Earlier this month, Fenerbahce celebrated winning the Turkish Cup with an 80-70 win over Efes. Gigi Datome starred with 22 points and 7 rebounds and Kostas Sloukas produced 19 points and 9 assists.

The two teams have played each other twice more domestically this season; Efes lifted the Turkish President's Cup with a 65-62 win in October and Fenerbahce registered an 86-79 overtime win in the Turkish League in November.

Fenerbahce guard Sinan Guler spent five seasons at Anadolu Efes from 2008 to 2013 and played a total of 67 EuroLeague games wearing the Efes jersey. He was a teammate of Efes captain Dogus Balbay.

Guler and Efes big man Tibor Pleiss were teammates at Galatasaray Istanbul during the 2016-17 season.

Fenerbahce guard Erick Green and Pleiss were teammates at Valencia Basket last season.

Fenerbahce's Marko Guduric and Vasilije Micic of Efes were teammates at Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade during the 2015-16 season. They helped the team reach the EuroLeague Playoffs and win Serbian and Adriatic League titles.

The two also teamed up on the Serbian national team and won silver medals at EuroBasket 2017.

Efes big man Bryant Dunston was a teammate of Fenerbahce point guard Kostas Sloukas at two different clubs for a total of three seasons. The two were first teammates at Aris Thessaloniki during the 2010-11 season and then from 2013 to 2015 at Olympiacos Piraeus.

Fenerbahce forward Baris Hersek started his professional career and made his EuroLeague debut with Efes in 2006 and spent two seasons there.

Fenerbahce big man Ahmet Duverioglu played for Efes during the 2015-16 season and was a teammate there of Balbay and Dunston.

Efes forward James Metecan Birsen grew up and made his EuroLeague debut with Fenerbahce. He played under Coach Zeljko Obradovic during the 2013-14 season and was a teammate there of Melih Mahmutoglu. Birsen was the 2012 EB Next Generation Tournament Finals MVP playing for U18 Fenerbahce.

Efes guard Krunoslav Simon came through the youth ranks at KK Zagreb and made his EuroLeague debut there in the 2011-12 season under current Fenerbahce assistant coach Vlado Androic.

Guler, Mahmutoglu, Hersek and Ali Muhammed were teammates of Balbay and Birsen on the Turkish national team. All but Birsen played under current Efes head coach Ergin Ataman.


Guler played under Coach Ataman at Galatasaray Istanbul for four seasons, from 2013 to 2017, too. They won the 7DAYS EuroCup title together in 2016.















Guler posted his career high in scoring with 20 points playing for Galatasaray against Efes in January 2017.















Fenerbahce big man Jan Vesely set career-highs with a performance index rating of 36 and 7 assists this season in the Round 4 loss against Efes.

Fenerbahce guard Ali Muhammed posted his career high in defensive rebounds with 7 for Fenerbahce against Efes in March 2017.

Nicolo Melli posted his career-high 6 offensive rebounds playing for AX Milan against Efes in October 2013.

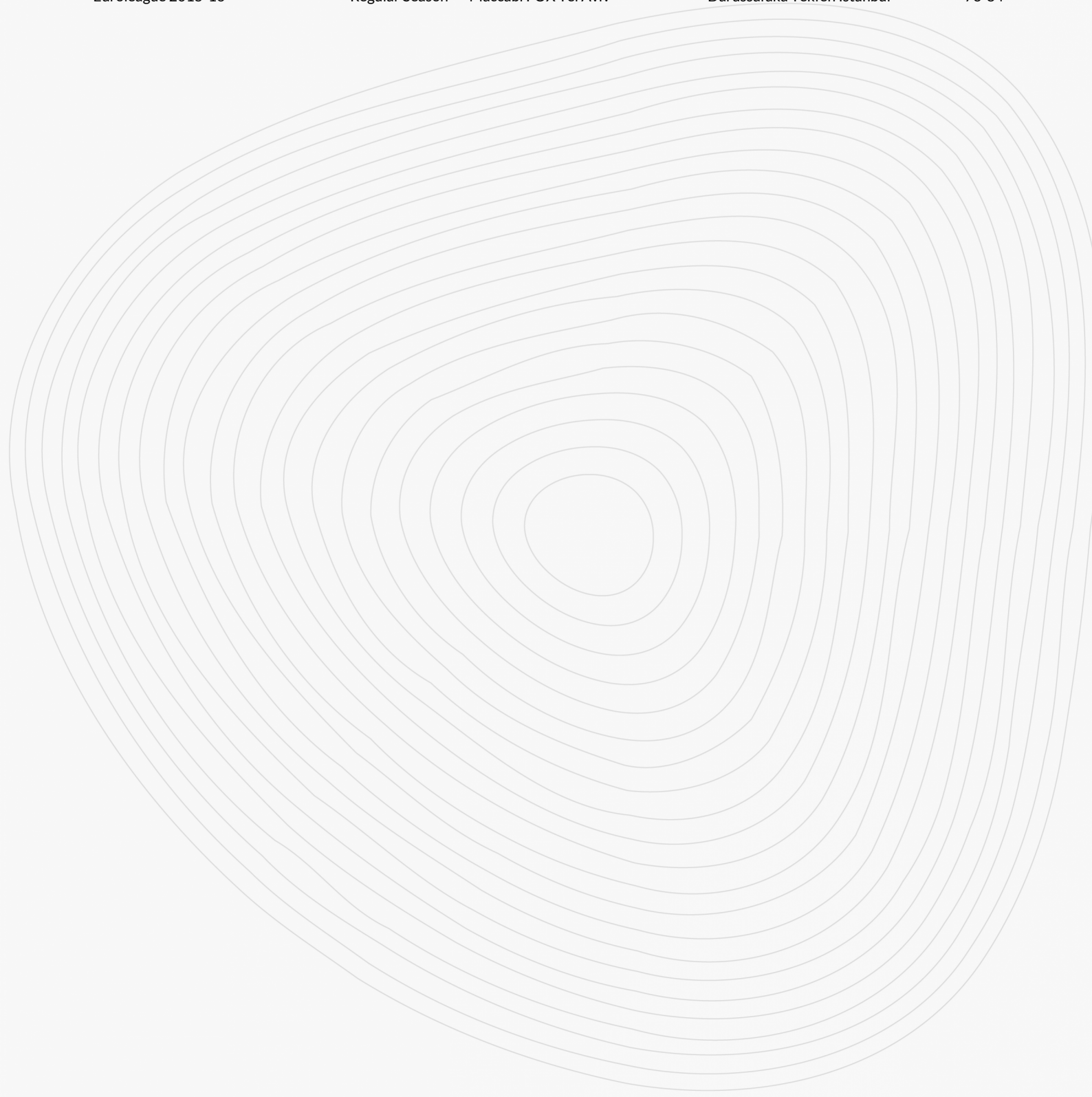

Wilbekin has made at least 1 three-pointer in five straight EuroLeague games.

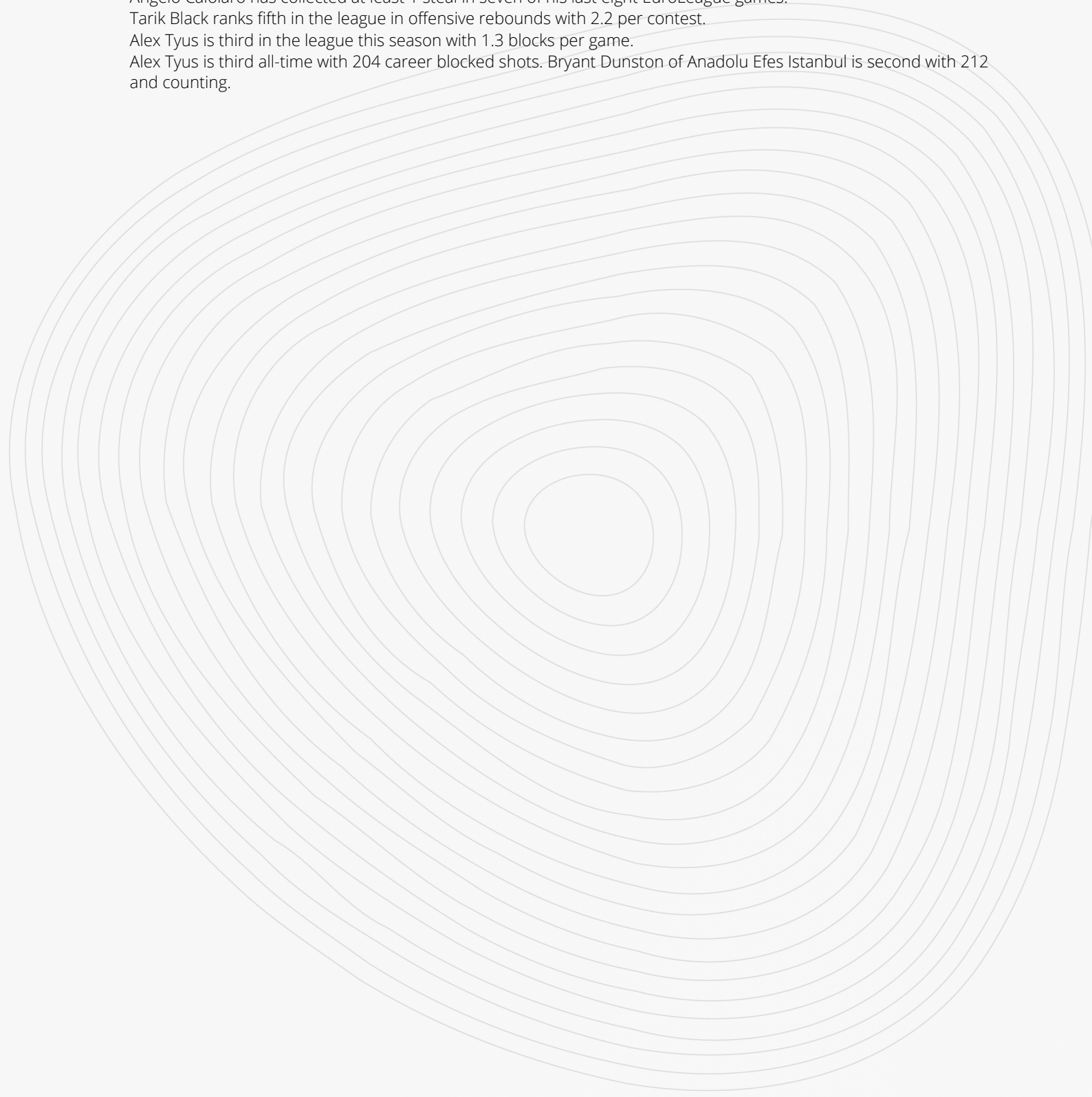
Tarik Black has posted a performance index rating in double figures in five straight games.

Game notes:

This is Darussafaka's third EuroLeague season and in each of the previous two, it played against Maccabi. Maccabi leads the series 3-2 after rallying from a 14-point deficit to edge Darussafaka 71-73 in Round 11. John DiBartolomeo came off the bench to lead Maccabi with 13 points. Johnny O'Bryant had his only EuroLeague double-double with 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Maccabi tied a club EuroLeague record with 9 blocked shots in its Round 11 win at Darussafaka.

Darussafaka big man Michael Eric posted his career high in points with 20 and had a career-high 3 blocks in the Round 11 loss.

Scottie Wilbekin spent three seasons with Darussafaka; he made his EuroLeague debut in the 2015-16 season and last season led the club to the 7DAYS EuroCup title. Wilbekin was the EuroCup MVP.

Darussafaka guard Jon Diebler and Maccabi big man Alex Tyus were teammates during the 2015-16 season at Anadolu Efes and again the following season at Galatasaray Istanbul.
















CSKA holds an 18-8 overall edge in games between the sides, including a 69-65 decision in Round 5 behind 20 points from Sergio Rodriguez and 17 points plus 9 rebounds from Will Clyburn. Olympiacos has won all four of their Final Four meetings since 2012.

CSKA and Olympiacos battled for the Turkish Airlines EuroLeague crown in the 2012 championship game in Istanbul. In one of the greatest comebacks in sports history, Olympiacos rallied from a 19-point deficit in the final 13 minutes to beat CSKA 62-61 on a game-winning shot by Georgios Printezis with 0.7 seconds left. Kostas Papanikolaou had a team-high 18 points in the game.

Olympiacos and CSKA met in the semifinals at the 2013 Final Four in London. The Reds rolled past CSKA Moscow 52-69. Kyle Hines and Pero Antic paced Olympiacos with 13 points apiece.

CSKA and Olympiacos battled in the 2015 Turkish Airlines EuroLeague Semifinals in Madrid. CSKA led 61-52 with less than four minutes left, but Vassilis Spanoulis scored 11 of his 13 points in crunch time to carry Olympiacos to a 68-70 victory. Spanoulis missed his first 11 shots of the game and had a performance index rating of minus-4 entering the fourth quarter.

Olympiacos mounted another famous comeback to take last season's semifinal, recovering from 13 points down to triumph 82-78 behind 14 points apiece from Vassilis Spanoulis, Georgios Printezis and Kostas Papanikolaou.

Kyle Hines spent two seasons with Olympiacos from 2011 through 2013 and helped the Reds win back-to-back EuroLeague titles. He was a teammate there of four current Olympiacos players: Vassilis Spanoulis, Georgios Printezis, Kostas Papanikolaou and Vangelis Mantzaris.

Hunter set a career high in blocks with 4 playing for Montepaschi Siena against Olympiacos in November 2013.

CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov has been a teammate of Olympiacos sharpshooter Janis Strelnieks; the two played together at Spartak St. Petersburg in the 2012-13 season.

CSKA guard Daniel Hackett played with Olympiacos for two seasons, from 2015 to 2017. He was a teammate there of several current Olympiacos players.

Olympiacos forward Axel Toupane was a teammate of CSKA guard Nando De Colo on the French national team at EuroBasket 2017.

CSKA forward Will Clyburn played under Olympiacos head coach David Blatt at Darussafaka Istanbul during the 2016-17 season.































Clyburn set his career-high with 4 steals in Round 5 against Olympiacos.


Nikita Kurbanov, Semen Antonov and Andrey Vorontsevich played under Coach Blatt on the Russian national team. Vorontsevich and Antonov won EuroBasket bronze in 2011 and Antonov also won Olympic bronze in 2012.

Game notes:

These archrivals met in the Spanish Cup final on February 17 in Madrid, with Barcelona taking a dramatic 93-94 overtime win as Thomas Heurtel shined for the winners with 22 points and 6 assists. Barcelona beat Madrid 86-69 in Spanish League action in late November with Kyle Kuric netting 16 points to lead the way.

Madrid has won last two EuroLeague El Clasicos by 27 points and has five straight wins over Barcelona in the EuroLeague by an average margin of 24.2 points. In their EuroLeague clash in Round 12 in mid-December, Madrid beat Barcelona 92-65; Trey Thompkins led the winners with 17 points.

Barcelona and Madrid have met in the semifinals of the EuroLeague Final Four on three occasions. The first was in 1996 when Barcelona won 76-66 in Paris behind 24 points from Arturas Karnisovas. Madrid was victorious 67-74 in London in 2013 thanks to 17 points from Felipe Reyes. The following season, Madrid routed Barcelona 62-100 in Milan, where Sergio Rodriguez starred with 21 points.

Madrid posted a EuroLeague club record 24 offensive rebounds against Barcelona in March 2005, a mark it has matched twice since.

Barcelona matched its EuroLeague club record with 9 blocks against Real Madrid in April 2006.

Barcelona set a club record with 35 made free throws against Madrid in March 2005.

Barcelona center Ante Tomic played two and a half seasons for Real Madrid between 2009 and 2012. He was a teammate there of current Madrid players, Felipe Reyes, Sergio Llull, Rudy Fernandez and Jaycee Carroll and played under Coach Pablo Laso in the 2011-12 season, too.

Madrid guard Fabien Causeur was a teammate of Barcelona players Thomas Heurtel, Adam Hanga and Jaka Blazic at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz. He played alongside his French countryman Heurtel for two and a half seasons, from 2012 to 2014; with Hanga in the 2013-14 and 2015-16 EuroLeague campaigns and with Jaka Blazic in the 2015-16 season. Causeur, Blazic and Hanga helped Baskonia reach the 2016 EuroLeague Final Four.

Barcelona center Kevin Seraphin and Causeur were teammates at Cholet during the 2009-10 season. The two were also teammates on the French national team, including at the 2012 Summer Olympics in London.

Real Madrid's Anthony Randolph was a teammate of Barcelona big men Chris Singleton and Victor Claver at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2015-16 season. They reached the EuroLeague Final Four together.

Madrid vet Rudy Fernandez and Pau Ribas of Barcelona were teammates at Joventut Badalona for four seasons, from 2004 to 2008. In recent years they have been teammates on the Spanish national team, too.

Barcelona's Claver and Madrid's Reyes, Llull and Fernandez have for years been teammates on the Spanish national team. Ribas joined all of them on Spain's silver-medal winning team at the 2016 Summer Olympics in Rio.

Madrid center Walter Tavares and Barcelona sharpshooter Kyle Kuric were teammates at Herbalife Gran Canaria during the 2014-15 season. Together they reached the EuroCup Finals.

Blazic and Madrid sharpshooter Klemen Prepelic played together for Union Olimpija Ljubljana in their native Slovenia during the 2012-13 season.

Blazic, Prepelic and Randolph have been teammates on the Slovenian national team and together won the EuroBasket 2017 championship.

Rudy Fernandez posted his career high in index rating with 38 for Real Madrid against FC Barcelona Lassa in February 2015. It earned him the last of his seven MVP of the Round honors.

Sergio Llull posted his career-best performance index rating of 32 in an 85-69 win against Barcelona in March 2017 and earned MVP of Round 27 honors for that performance.

Randolph matched his career-best with 28 points playing for Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar against Barcelona in Game 4 of the 2016 EuroLeague Playoffs. Randolph accumulated a performance index rating of 28 in that game and earned MVP of the Round honors.

Madrid big man Trey Thompkins set a career-high with 4 steals in an 87-75 win against Barcelona in December of last season.
