- Efes won twice against Maccabi last season. In Round 10, which is the last time the two teams met in Tel Aviv, Derrick Brown earned weekly MVP honors with 22 points and a career-high 12 rebounds in a 77-86 road win.
- In their last meeting, a 92-87 Efes home win in March, Bryant Dunston posted a career-high 12 rebounds.
- Derrick Brown posted his career high in index rating with 38 for Anadolu Efes Istanbul against Maccabi FOX Tel Aviv on January 12, 2016.
- DeShaun Thomas played for Anadolu Efes Istanbul last season. He played under current Efes head coach and alongside Dogus Balbay, Derrick Brown and Bryant Dunston.
- DeShaun Thomas was a teammate of Efes forward Justin Doellman at FC Barcelona Lassa during the 2014-15 season.
- Alex Tyus played at Anadolu Efes during the 2015-16 season. He was a teammate of with three current Efes players: Dogus Balbay, Derrick Brown and Bryant Dunston.
- Tyus was also a teammate with Errick McCollum at Galatasaray Odeabank Istanbul at the end of last season.
- Tyus had one of his best EuroLeague games against Efes in December of last season. He posted 15 points, 13 rebounds and 3 blocks for a career-high performance index rating of 29 in a 76-86 loss.
- Artsiom Parakhouski scored a career-best 27 points and posted his career high in index rating with 37 for Nizhny Novgorod against Efes in January of 2015.
- Parakhouski posted his career high in offensive rebounds with 7 for Unics Kazan against Efes in November of 2016.
- Krunoslav Simon posted his career high in assists with 9 for Milan against Maccabi in October of last year.

- Art Parakhouski is ranked fifth the league with 1.2 blocked shots per game.
- Alex Tyus is ranked seventh on the all-time EuroLeague charts in blocked shots with 151.
- Tyus needs 9 blocks to catch Stephane Lasme for sixth place. Lasme has 160 for his career.
- Art Parakhouski needs 11 more blocked shots to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.

Johannes Voigtmann registered a double-double of 18 points and 11 rebounds in a thrilling 87-91 Baskonia win in Madrid, before Luka Doncic posted 16 points, 9 rebounds and 6 assists as Madrid gained revenge 71-79 in Vitoria.
- Baskonia's Marcelinho Huertas and Rudy Fernandez of Real Madrid played together at Joventut Badalona for three seasons, from 2004 to 2007.
- Fabien Causeur played for Baskonia for four full seasons, from 2012 to 2016. He was a teammate of current Baskonia players Ilimane Diop and Tornike Shengelia.
- Coach Pablo Laso spent the bulk of his playing career in Vitoria with Baskonia in the 1990s. He helped lead the club to its first ever title, the 1995 Copa del Rey, as well as back-to-back Saporta Cup final appearances.
- Madrid's Anthony Randolph and Baskonia's Matt Janning were teammates at Lokomotiv for the second part of the 2015-16 season; they helped the club reach the EuroLeague Final Four together.
- Madrid's Jaycee Carroll played under Coach Pedro Martinez at Gran Canaria for two seasons from 2009 through 2011.
- Luca Vildoza and Patricio Garino were teammates with Facundo Campazzo on the Argentinian national team last summer. They won the silver medal at Fiba Americup.
- Johannes Voigtmann posted career highs with 7 offensive rebounds and 5 assists for Baskonia against Madrid last season in February.
- Rodrigue Beaubois posted a career high 6 assists for Strasbourg against Madrid in November 2015.
- Matt Janning had career-highs of 21 points and a performance index rating of 21 playing for Anadolu Efes Istanbul against Madrid in April 2015.
- Anthony Randolph posted his career high in defensive rebounds with 12 for Real Madrid against Baskonia in October of last year.
- Jonas Maciulis set his career high in index rating with 28 for Panathinaikos against Baskonia in November 2013.
