- Panathinaikos has dominated its fellow men in green with 15-3 record in games between them, however Zalgiris has won two of their last three meetings in Lithuania.
- The teams split home wins last season. In the opening round of the campaign, Panathinaikos won 84-76 in Athens behind 19 points from Nikos Pappas, but Zalgiris gained revenge with a 64-58 triumph in Kaunas with Arturas Milaknis contributing 13.
- Panathinaikos set a club-record for two-pointers made in the EuroLeague this century with 34 against Zalgiris in December 2011.
- Zalgiris head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius played four seasons for Panathinaikos from 2007 through 2010 and again in 2011-12. In that time he helped the Greens to the 2009 EuroLeague title and to three Greek League and Greek Cup crowns. He was a teammate there of current Panathinaikos players Nick Calathes and Ian Vougioukas.
- Zalgiris head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius played under current Panathinaikos head coach Xavi Pascual at FC Barcelona Lassa during the 2012-13 season.
- Ian Vougioukas played for Zalgiris during the 2015-16 season, when he was a teammate of current Zalgiris players Paulius Jankunas, Edgaras Ulanovas and Martynas Sajus and played under Coach Jasikevicius.
- Lukas Lekavicius grew up with Zalgiris Kaunas, and spent his first three professional seasons there before joining Panathinaikos over the summer. He has been teammates with most of the current Zalgiris roster and played under Coach Sarunas Jasikevicius.
- Zalgiris guard Vaslije Micic and Panathinaikos swingman K.C. Rivers were teammate at FC Bayern Munich for the first part of the 2015-16 season.
- KC Rivers posted his career high in rebounds with 9 playing for Real Madrid against Zalgiris in April 2015.
- Panathinaikos big man Chris Singleton set his career high in offensive rebounds with 5 in an 84-76 win over Zalgiris in October of last season.
- Panathinaikos forward Kenny Gabriel posted his career high in blocks with 3 for Karsiyaka Spor Izmir against Zalgiris in December 2015.

- Brandon Davies, Paulius Jankunas and Kevin Pangos have each started every EuroLeague game for Zalgiris this season.
- Kevin Pangos has made at least 1 three-pointer in 12 of his last 13 EuroLeague games.
- Kevin Pangos is tied fifth in the EuroLeague with 5.1 assists per game.
- Pangos is tied third in the EuroLeague with an average of 2.4 three-pointers made per game.
- Paulius Jankunas is ranked second on the EuroLeague all-time charts with 456 offensive boards.
- Jankunas is third on the all-time rebounding charts with 1,561 rebounds.
- Jankunas is ranked sixth on the all-time scoring list with 2,591 points.
- Jankunas is in sixth place on the all-time list with 272 EuroLeague appearances.
- Jankunas needs 2 steals to reach 200 for his EuroLeague career.

- CSKA won a thriller 88-90 thanks to Vitaly Fridzon's buzzer-beating game-winner in Bamberg last season and prevailed more comfortably at home as Nando De Colo scored 26 points in an 85-64 victory.
- Nikos Zisis played two seasons for CSKA between 2007 and 2009. Only forwards Victor Khryapa, Andrey Vorontsvich and Nikita Kurbanov remain from his time at the club. Together they won the EuroLeague in 2008.
- CSKA's Othello Hunter was a teammate of Brose Bamberg's Daniel Hackett for the first part of the 2013-14 campaign at Montepaschi Siena.
- CSKA's big man Kyle Hines played at Brose Bamberg for the 2010-11 season. He was the team's best scorer in the EuroLeague that season and helped it win German championship, too.
- CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov played under Coach Trinchieri and alongside Nikos Zisis at UNICS Kazan during the 2013-14 season. Trinchieri was EuroCup coach of the Year and they all reached the EuroCup final together.
- Brose forward Luka Mitrovic posted his career high in assists with 9 playing for Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade against CSKA in March of last season.
- CSKA forward Will Clyburn scored a career-high 26 points and had a career-best performance index rating of 33 playing for Darussafaka Istanbul against Brose in March of last season.
- Victor Khryapa posted his career high in rebounds with 14 in a 90-83 win over Brose in January 2013.

- Kyle Hines has not missed a EuroLeague game since January 2014 and appeared in 121 consecutive games for CSKA in that span.
- Coach Dimitris Itoudis has used 11 different players in the CSKA starting lineup so far this season. No player has started every game.
- Nando De Colo has scored in double figures and posted a performance index rating of at least 10 in each of his last seven EuroLeague games.
- De Colo has recorded at least 1 steal in eight straight EuroLeague games.
- Cory Higgins has scored in double figures in each of his last five EuroLeague games.
- Higgins has made at least 1 three-pointer in 10 of his last 11 EuroLeague games.
- Kyle Hines has blocked at least 1 shot in six straight EuroLeague games.
- Sergio Rodriguez has made multiple three-pointers in each of his last four EuroLeague games.
- Nando De Colo is ranked second among qualified EuroLeague players this season in average performance index rating with 20.5 per game.

- Sergio Rodriguez is tied with Pablo Prigioni for eighth place on the all-time EuroLeague assists charts with 804. Bamberg's Nikos Zisis is seventh with 834 and counting.

- Centers Alex Tyus of Maccabi and Tibor Pleiss of Valencia were teammates at Galatasaray Odeabank Istanbul last season.
- Pleiss was also a teammate of Maccabi forward Deshaun Thomas at FC Barcelona during the 2014-15 season.
- Maccabi center Art Parakhouski and his injured Valencia counterpart Latavious Williams played together the last two seasons at UNICS Kazan.
- Will Thomas scored a career-high 20 points and posted a career-best index rating of 24 playing for Unicaja Malaga against Maccabi in November 2015.
