- Barcelona and Panathinaikos squared off in the 1996 EuroLeague final in Paris, France. Panathinaikos edged Barcelona 67-66 to conquer its first EuroLeague title. Panathinaikos legend Fragiskos Alvertis led the way with 17 points.
- Panathinaikos head coach Xavi Pascual coached Barcelona from 2008 until 2016. In those seven-plus seasons, he guided the club to 19 trophies, highlighted by the 2010 EuroLeague title.
- Panathinaikos forward Chris Singleton was a teammate of Barcelona's Victor Claver at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar two seasons ago. They led the team to the EuroLeague Final Four.
- Singleton had one of the best games of his EuroLeague career playing for Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar against Barcelona. In the decisive Game 5 of the 2016 playoffs, he had 16 points and a career-high 12 rebounds in accumulating a performance index rating of 27 in an 81-67 victory that saw Lokomotiv claim a place at the Final Four. Singleton earned Playoffs Game 5 MVP honors.
- In the Round 1 loss against Barcelona, Singleton blocked a career-high 4 shots.
- Barcelona guard Petteri Koponen and Panathinaikos sharpshooter K.C. Rivers were teammates at Khimki Moscow Region during the 2012-13 season.
- Barcelona playmaker Phil Pressey was a college teammate of Panathinaikos guard Marcus Denmon at the University of Missouri.
- Barcelona forward Sasha Vezenkov and his Panathinaikos counterpart Eleftherios Bochoridis were teammates at Aris Thessaloniki for three years, from 2011 through 2014.
- Vezenkov was also a teammate of Panathinaikos big man Konstantinos Mitoglou at Aris during the 2013-14 season.

- Chris Singleton needs 1 more three-pointer to reach the century mark for his EuroLeague career.
- Singleton needs 3 more steals to reach 100 for his EuroLeague career.
- K.C. Rivers needs 4 more steals to reach the century mark for his EuroLeague career.

- Coach Sito Alonso has used 11 different starters this season. No player has started every game.
- Petteri Koponen has made 20 straight free throws in EuroLeague games.
- Pau Ribas has made at least 1 three-pointer in each of his last five EuroLeague appearances. He is shooting 12 for 20 (60%) from downtown over that stretch.
- Thomas Heurtel is second in the EuroLeague in assists this season with 6.7 per game.
- Juan Carlos Navarro is the EuroLeague career leader in scoring (4,058 points) and three-pointers made (606) and ranks third in free throws made (838).
- Navarro is ninth on the all-time EuroLeague assists charts with 813. Sergio Rodriguez of CSKA Moscow is eighth with 838 and counting.
- Navarro is in seventh place all-time with 246 career steals. Retired CSKA great J.R. Holden and Real Madrid forward Jonas Maciulis are tied for fifth with 247 steals.
- Petteri Koponen is ranked fourth all-time in the EuroLeague in free throw accuracy at 91.67%.
- Ante Tomic is in sixth place all-time with 1,187 rebounds in EuroLeague games. Kerem Gonlum is in fifth place with 1,189.
- Tomic is ranked third on the all-time charts with 855 two-point shots for his career. Felipe Reyes of Real Madrid is second with 877 and counting.
- Tomic needs 2 more steals to reach the century mark for his EuroLeague career.
- Tomic is closing in on a spot in the EuroLeague all-time top 10 in blocks. He is 12th with 134 career blocks; D'Or Fischer is 11th with 138 and 10th place belongs to Denis Marconato with 140.
- Thomas Heurtel is fifth all-time with 920 career-assists. Theo Papaloukas is fourth with 977.

- CSKA forward Nikita Kurbanov was a teammate of Milan guard Mantas Kalnietis at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2014-15 season.
- Kurbanov and Milan scorer Andrew Goudelock were teammates at UNICS Kazan during the 2013-14 season when they reached EuroCup Finals together.
- CSKA forward Will Clyburn and Milan sharpshooter Dairis Bertans were teammates at Darussafaka Istanbul last season; they helped the team make the Turkish Airlines EuroLeague playoffs.
- In a Round 1 win, Will Clyburn set career highs with 12 rebounds and 3 steals.
- Vladimir Micov played for CSKA Moscow for two seasons from 2012 to 2014, during which he reached a pair of EuroLeague Final Fours and won a pair of VTB League titles with the club. He was a teammates there of current CSKA players Andrey Vorontsevich and Victor Khryapa for both years and with Vitaly Fridzon and Kyle Hines during his second season with the club.
- Nando De Colo earned Top 16 Round 7 MVP honors in the 2014-15 season after shining in CSKA's 97-75 victory over EA7 Emporio Armani. He tallied 18 points, 7 assists and 4 steals for a performance index rating of 29.
- Vitaly Fridzon posted his career high in rebounds with 9 playing for CSKA Moscow against AX Armani Exchange Olimpia Milan in February 2015.
