- Barcelona has won 12 of its last 13 meetings against Maccabi dating back to 2009, including the last four in a row.
- Barcelona claimed a comfortable home win in Round 9, when Petteri Koponen and Rakim Sanders combined for 10 three-pointers in an 89-67 victory.
- Maccabi and Barcelona faced each other in the 1991 EuroLeague Final Four in Paris, France. Barcelona thrashed Maccabi 101-67 in the first semifinal behind Jose Antonio Montero, who shined with 25 points off the bench.
- Maccabi and Barcelona met in the 2000 EuroLeague semifinals in Thessaloniki, Greece. Maccabi prevailed 51-65 thanks to 24 points from Nate Huffman.
- Maccabi forward DeShaun Thomas played at FC Barcelona Lassa during the 2014-15 season and was a teammate there of Juan Carlos Navarro and Ante Tomic.
- Maccabi center Alex Tyus and Barcelona point guard Thomas Heurtel were teammates at Anadolu Efes Istanbul for the 2015-16 season.
- Victor Claver played under current Maccabi head coach Neven Spahija at Valencia Basket for two seasons, from 2008 to 2010. They won the 2010 EuroCup title together, and Claver won the 2010 EuroCup Rising Star award.
- Barcelona center Ante Tomic earned 2014-15 Top 16 Round 10 MVP honors against Maccabi after posting 16 points, 12 rebounds and 6 assists for a performance index rating of 35 on March 12, 2015.
- In February of last season, Alex Tyus matched his career-high in points with 19 playing for Galatasaray Odeabank Istanbul against Barcelona.

- Art Parakhouski has made 10 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.
- DeShaun Thomas has made at least 1 three-pointer in five straight EuroLeague games.
- Jonah Bolden is fourth in the EuroLeague in blocks this season with 1.15 per game, and Alex Tyus is fifth with 1.14 blocks per contest.
- Alex Tyus is in fifth place on the all-time EuroLeague charts in blocked shots with 169, trailing two active players; Bryant Dunston (171) is fourth and Kyle Hines (177) third.

- Edwin Jackson has made his season debut in Round 21.
- Kevin Seraphin remains sidelined with a knee injury.
- Coach Sito Alonso has used 12 different starters this season. No player has started every game.
- Petteri Koponen has made 22 straight free throws in EuroLeague games.
- Pau Ribas has made 13 straight free throws in EuroLeague games.
- Thomas Heurtel is third in the EuroLeague in assists this season with 6.2 per game.
- Rakim Sanders is second in the EuroLeague with 1.6 steals per game.
- Juan Carlos Navarro is the EuroLeague career leader in scoring (4,086 points) and three-pointers made (611) and ranks third in free throws made (843).
- Navarro is ninth on the all-time EuroLeague assists charts with 821.
- Navarro is in seventh place all-time with 246 career steals. Retired CSKA great J.R. Holden is sixth with 247 steals.
- Thomas Heurtel is second on the EuroLeague all-time assists charts among qualified players with 5.65 assists per game.
- Thomas Heurtel is fifth all-time with 944 career-assists. Theo Papaloukas is fourth with 977.
- Petteri Koponen is ranked third all-time in the EuroLeague in free throw accuracy at 91.82%.
- Ante Tomic is in the fifth place all-time with 1,212 rebounds in EuroLeague games. Fourth place belongs to Mirsad Turkcan with 1,287.
- Tomic is ranked third on the all-time charts with 878 two-point shots for his career. Felipe Reyes of Real Madrid is second with 891 and counting.
- Tomic is closing in on a spot in the EuroLeague all-time top 10 in blocks. He is ranked 13th with 135 career blocks; D'Or Fischer and Tibor Pleiss of Valencia Basket are tied for 11th with 138, and 10th place belongs to Denis Marconato with 140.

- Baskonia swept Panathinaikos in the 2016 playoffs.
- Panathinaikos and Baskonia battled in the 2007 EuroLeague semifinals in Athens, Greece. Panathinaikos downed Baskonia 53-67 behind 15 points each from Sani Becirovic and Mike Batiste. The Greens went on to win the EuroLeague title.
- Panathinaikos tied its record for rebounds in EuroLeague play this century with 51 against Baskonia in April 2016.
- Panathinaikos set its club EuroLeague records with 31 assists and 18 three-pointers against Baskonia in October 2013.
- Panathinaikos center Ian Vougioukas and Baskonia guard Matt Janning were teammates at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar last season.
- Panathinaikos playmaker Nick Calathes set his career high with 14 assists in the Round 5 loss in Vitoria.
- Baskonia big man Ilimane Diop set his career-high with 10 rebounds in December of last season against Panathinaikos. He also had a career-best 3 steals against Panathinaikos in March 2014.
- Panathinaikos forward James Gist set a career-high with 11 rebounds against Baskonia in November 2010, playing for Partizan Belgrade.

- Nando De Colo and Leo Westerman have been backcourt teammates on the French national team with injured Valencia's point guard Antoine Diot.
- CSKA playmaker Sergio Rodriguez was a teammate of Valencia's Fernando San Emeterio, Joan Sastre and Guillem Vives with the Spanish national team last summer at EuroBasket 2017. Together they won the bronze medal.
- Kyle Hines and his Valencia counterpart Tibor Pleiss were frontcourt partners during the 2010-11 season with Brose Bamberg. For both of them it was their debut EuroLeague season. They won the German League and Cup double together.
- CSKA center Othello Hunter was a teammate of Valencia guard Erick Green during the 2013-14 campaign at Montepaschi Siena.
- Valencia swingman Fernando San Emeterio posted his career high in offensive rebounds with 5 playing for Baskonia Vitoria Gasteiz against CSKA on April 1, 2010.
