- In Round 7, CSKA cruised to 59-85 decision in Belgrade, with Nando De Colo scoring 16 points, and Sergio Rodriguez posting 11 points and 9 assists.
- CSKA swept Zvezda 3-0 in the 2015-16 EuroLeague Playoffs en route to winning its seventh EuroLeague title.
- Crvena Zvezda and CSKA faced each other in the 1972-73 European Cup semifinals. CSKA swept the two-game series, winning 90-98 in Belgrade and 100-83 in Moscow.
- Kyle Hines was a teammate of Zvezda big man Pero Antic for two seasons at Olympiacos Piraeus, where they won EuroLeague titles together in 2012 and 2013.
- Zvezda playmaker Taylor Rochestie and CSKA big man Othello Hunter were teammates at Montepaschi Siena for part of the 2013-14 season.
- Nemanja Dangubic set his career high in assists with 5 for Crvena Zvezda against CSKA in April of last year.
- Cory Higgins set his career high in rebounds with 9 for CSKA against Crvena Zvezda in April of 2016.
- Nikita Kurbanov scored a career-high 18 points and set his career high in performance index rating with 29 for CSKA against Crvena Zvezda in February of last season.

- Coach Dimitris Itoudis has used 11 different players in the CSKA starting lineup so far this season. No player has started every game.
- Nando De Colo has scored in double figures in six straight and 14 of his last 15 EuroLeague games.
- De Colo has made at least 1 three-pointer in each of his last six EuroLeague games; he's made multiple threes in five of those games and is shooting 17 for 27 from downtown (63.0%) from downtown over that stretch.
- Sergio Rodriguez has made 12 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.
- Rodriguez has collected at least 1 steal in each of his last six EuroLeague appearances.
- Nikita Kurbanov has made 20 consecutive free throws in EuroLeague games.
- Nando De Colo is ranked second among qualified EuroLeague players this season in average performance index rating with 20.2 per game.
- De Colo is second in the EuroLeague in scoring with 17.2 points per game.
- De Colo is tied fifth in steals with 1.3 per contest.
- De Colo led all qualified EuroLeague players in free-throw accuracy last season by making 95.8% of his attempts.
- Othello Hunter is tied fifth in the league in offensive rebounds with 2.4 per game.
- Sergio Rodriguez is second in the EuroLeague this season with 2.6 three-pointers made per game.
- De Colo is the EuroLeague career leader in free throw accuracy at 93.55%.
- Sergio Rodriguez is seventh on the all-time EuroLeague assists charts with 896. Next on the list is his former Real Madrid teammate Sergio Llull with 902.
- Kyle Hines is third on the all-time EuroLeague charts with 440 offensive rebounds for his career.
- Hines is fourth all-time with 180 career blocks. Anadolu Efes center Bryant Dunston is third with 186 blocks and counting.
- Victor Khryapa ranks 10th on the all-time EuroLeague charts with 1,067 career rebounds. Former Panathinaikos star Mike Batiste is in ninth place with 1,117.
- Khryapa is ranked eighth on the all-time charts with 241 career steals. Khryapa's former teammate J.R. Holden is seventh with 247.
- Khryapa is seventh on the all-time charts with 161 blocks for his career. He needs 1 more to catch Mirza Begic, who has 162 in sixth place.

- Dragan Milosavljevic posted a career-best 5 assists, and set a career high in index rating with 26 playing for Partizan NIS Belgrade against Fenerbahce in December of 2013.
- Jeff Brooks posted his career high in assists with 6 for Pallacanestro Cantu against Fenerbahce Dogus Istanbul in December of 2012.

- Milan guard Mantas Kalnietis was a teammate of Panathinaikos playmaker Nick Calathes for a season at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar. They won the 2013 EuroCup. Calathes was named EuroCup MVP that year.
- Panathinaikos point guard Lukas Lekavicius and his Milan counterpart Mantas Kalnietis both grew up with Zalgiris Kaunas. They were teammates with Zalgiris for the first part of the 2015-16 season, and have also been teammates on the Lithuanian national team.
- Milan big man Arturas Gudaitis was a teammate of Lekavicius at Zalgiris during the 2014-15 season.
- Panathinaikos center Ian Vougioukas and Milan guard Andrew Goudelock were teammates at UNICS Kazan during the 2013-14 season. Goudelock was named EuroCup MVP and they reached the EuroCup Finals together.
- Vougioukas was also a teammate of Milan's Vladimir Micov at Galatasaray Odeabank Istanbul for part of the 2014-15 season.
- Milan playmaker Andrea Cinciarini posted his career high in performance index rating with 20 and grabbed a career-best 8 rebounds for Milan against Panathinaikos in March of last season.
- Milan forward Awudu Abass scored a career-high 15 points for Milan against Panathinaikos in March of last season.
