Dzanan Musa ranks 10th this season in scoring with 15.1 per game.

Walter Tavares ranks fifth this season in average index rating with 17.4 per game.

Tavares leads the league this season in blocks with 2.2 per game.

Tavares ranks third this season in rebounding with 6.6 per game.

Tavares ranks third this season in offensive rebounding with 2.6 per game.

Mario Hezonja ranks ninth this season in three-point accuracy at 45.2%.

Records/Milestones

Sergio Llull ranks third in playoff history in assists with 164. Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is second with 167, and Vassilis Spanoulis is the all-time leader with 189.

Sergio Rodriguez ranks seventh in playoff history in assists with 146. Milos Teodosic and Dimitris Diamantidis are tied for fifth with 147 apiece.

Llull ranks third in playoff history in scoring with 474 points. Juan Carlos Navarro is second with 509. Spanoulis is the all-time leader with 531 points.

Rodriguez is fifth in playoff history in scoring with 372 points. Georgios Printezis is fourth with 381.

Rudy Fernandez ranks seventh in playoff history in scoring with 333 points. Ante Tomic is sixth with 359 points.

Llull is sixth in playoff history in accumulated performance index rating with 410, and Kostas Sloukas of Olympiacos Piraeus is fifth with 411 and counting.

Fernandez ranks eighth in playoff history in accumulated performance index rating with 371. Kyle Hines is seventh with 408.

Game facts: Real Madrid

Llull ranks second in playoff history with 75 three-point shots made. Juan Carlos Navarro is the all-time playoff leader with 81 triples made.

Rodriguez is in third place in playoff history with 65 three-pointers made.

Rudy Fernandez ranks fifth in playoff history with 62 three-point shots made, Vassilis Spanoulis is fourth with 63.

Fernandez and Llull are tied for ninth in playoff history in free throws made with 73 apiece. Sloukas is eighth with 76, and Nando De Colo is seventh with 77.

Fernandez is in fifth place in playoff history with 34 steals. Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is fourth with 38 steals and counting.

Walter Tavares is in fourth place in playoff history with 23 blocks. Kyle Hines is third fifth with 25 blocks.

Sergio Llull ranks fifth all-time in scoring with 3,676 points. Mike James of AS Monaco is fourth with 3,882 and counting.

Sergio Rodriguez ranks seventh all-time with 3,584 points scored. Georgios Printezis is sixth with 3,599.

Rodriguez is second all-time with 1,718 assists. Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is the all-time leader with 1,900 and counting.

Llull is sixth all-time with 1,322 assists. His former teammate Thomas Heurtel is fifth with 1,340.

Llull ranks 12th all-time with 667 free throws made. Jan Vesely of FC Barcelona is 11th with 669, and Jaka Lakovic is 10th with 673.

Llull ranks second all-time with a 2.8-to-1 career assist-to-turnover ratio, Nigel Williams-Goss is 16th at 2.4-to-1 and Rudy Fernandez is 19th at 2.4-to-1.

Llull is in second place all-time with 577 three-point shots made; Fernandez and Rodriguez are tied for third with 571 apiece. Juan Carlos Navarro is the all-time leader with 623.

Fernandez is ranked third all-time with 343 steals. Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is second with 408 and counting.

Fernandez needs 47 points to reach 3,000 for his career.

Rodriguez is in eighth place all-time with 289 career steals. Jan Vesely of FC Barcelona is seventh with 301 and counting.

Rodriguez is ninth all-time with 3,888 index rating points. Juan Carlos Navarro is eighth with 3,890.

Walter Tavares is the competition's all-time leader with 367 blocks.

Tavares is third all-time in two-point accuracy at 69.1%.

Tavares is ranked seventh all-time with 523 offensive rebounds. Jan Vesely is sixth with 556 and counting.

Mathias Lessort has grabbed at least 6 rebounds in nine of his last 10 games.

Kevin Punter has scored 14 or more points in 14 of his last 15 games.

Punter has made at least 1 three-point shot in eight straight and 19 of his last 20 games.

Punter has made 56 consecutive free throws. That is the second-longest streak in EuroLeague history. Igor Rakocevic set the record with 58 straight free throws made in 2008.

James Nunnally has made 25 consecutive free throws.

Dante Exum has PIRs of 13 or more in four of his last five games.

Zach LeDay had double-digit PIRs in six straight nine of his last 10 games.

LeDay scored in 13 or more points in five of his last six games.

Kevin Punter ranks ninth this season in scoring with 15.8 per game.

Punter ranks 10th this season in three-pointers made with 2.1 per game.

Mathias Lessort ranks second this season in average index rating with 19.2 per game.

Lessort leads the leaque this season in rebounding with 7.2 per game.

Lessort leads the league this season in offensive rebounding with 3.1 per game.

Game notes: Real Madrid vs Partizan Mozzart Bet Belgrade

- This is the first EuroLeaque playoff series that has featured road wins in each of the first four games.
- Real registered a 78-85 victory in Game 4 behind 15 points, 7 rebounds, 2 blocks and 2 steals from Walter Tavares, who had a PIR of 30 and earned MVP of the Round honors.
- Real pulled out an 80-82 win in Game 3 as Walter Tavares tied his career-high with 26 points plus 11 rebounds, 3 assists and 3 blocks. His career-best PIR of 41 tied for the second-highest in modern playoff history.
- Earlier in the series, Partizan became just the second team in playoff history to win Games 1 and 2 on the road.
- Partizan won the series opener 87-89 on a game-winning triple by Kevin Punter with 0.4 seconds to go. - Punter netted 26 points on 5-for-8 three-point shooting and 6 assists, all new playoff highs for him. He earned MVP of the Round honors, tying his career best with a PIR of 33.
- It was an 80-95 Partizan win in Game 2, which was stopped with 1:40 to go in the fourth quarter after an on-court altercation that left both teams without the required minimum of two players required to finish the game. Dante Exum scored 19 points and James Nunnally 16 for Partizan in the win.
- Before this series and Partizan's two wins in Madrid, Real was 9-0 at home against Partizan this century and 11-0 all-time dating back to 1979.
- Real has won 17 of 22 games against Partizan this century; the teams split home wins during the regular season.
- In Round 10 in Madrid, Real beat Partizan 105-97. In that game, Partizan took the first quarter 32-40. The 72 combined points set a record for most points in a first quarter and the second most in any quarter of a EuroLeague game.
- When they played in Belgrade, in Round 32, Partizan beat Real 104-90 behind 16 points and 8 rebounds from Mathias Lessort. It is the only time Los Blancos allowed 100 or more points in a road game since January 2020.
- Coach Zeljko Obradovic led Real Madrid to the EuroLeague title in 1995. That was the eighth continental crown for Real and the third as head coach for Obradovic. He was Real Madrid's head coach for three seasons, from 1994 to 1997.
- Partizan forward Tristan Vukcevic joined Real Madrid as a teenager and made his professional debut there before joining Partizan in the middle of last season.
- Partizan guard Kevin Punter and forward Zach LeDay were teammates with Real point guard Sergio Rodriguez at EA7 Emporio Armani Milan during the 2020-21 season. They helped the team reach the 2021 Final Four.
- LeDay and Real guard Nigel Williams-Goss were teammates at Olympiacos Piraeus during the 2018-19 season.



Game notes: Real Madrid vs Partizan Mozzart Bet Belgrade

- Williams-Goss played for Partizan during the 2017-18 season; he made his European debut with the club.
- Partizan center Mathias Lessort and Real center Vincent Poirier have been teammates on the French national team. Together they won bronze medals at the 2019 FIBA World Cup.
- Real forward Mario Hezonja and his Partizan counterpart Ioannis Papapetrou were teammates at Panathinaikos Athens in the second part of the 2020-21 season.
- In Game 3, Real forward Mario Hezonja set a new career high with 14 rebounds.
- Real's Dzanan Musa collected a career-high 8 rebounds in Game 4.
- Partizan forward Zach Leday made a career-best 12 two-point shots on 14 attempts in a Game 4 loss.
- Leday dished a career-high 6 assists in Round 10 against Real Madrid.
- Gabriel Deck tied his career high in PIR with 33 in Game 1 of this series.
- Partizan guard Kevin Punter had a career-high 6 assists in Round 32 against Real Madrid and he matched that in Game 1.
- Partizan swingman James Nunnally had a career-high 8 rebounds playing for Maccabi Tel Aviv against Real in April of last season.
