With his next appearance in a Final Four game, Kostas Papanikolaou will move into a tie with JR Holden for eighth place all-time with 16 appearances in Final Four games.

Papanikolaou has 13 starts in Final Four games this century, which is tied for the second most with Victor Khryapa. JR Holden is the leader with 15 starts in Final Four games.

Papanikolaou is tied with Kostas Sloukas of Panathinaikos AKTOR Athens for 11th place in Final Fours this century with 20 three-point shots made. Jaycee Carroll and David Blue are tied for ninth with 21 triples apiece, while Sarunas Jasikevicius and Vassilis Spanoulis are tied for seventh with 22 apiece.

Sloukas is ranked fourth all-time with 5,064 index rating points. Jan Vesely of FC Barcelona is third with 5,123.

Sloukas is 12th all-time with 509 three-point shots made. Nando De Colo of LDLC ASVEL Villeurbanne is 11th with 510, and Rodrigue Beaubois of Anadolu Efes Istanbul is 10th with 513.

Marius Grigonis ranks eighth all-time in free-throw accuracy at 90.6%.

Sloukas is in 18th place on the all-time charts with 269 career steals. Vassilis Spanoulis is 17th with 273 steals.

Tibor Pleiss is ranked seventh all-time with 229 career blocks. Alex Tyus is sixth with 238.

Pleiss is in 11th place all-time with 470 offensive rebounds. Vincent Poirier of Efes is in 10th place all-time with 480 offensive rebounds.

Pleiss is in 12th place all-time with 1,009 two-pointers made. Nick Calathes of AS Monaco is 11th all-time with 1,010 two-pointers made. Paulius Jankunas is 10th with 1,011.

Kostas Sloukas is in second place all-time with 21 Final Four games played. Victor Khryapa is the leader with 23.

Kostas Sloukas ranks third in Final Fours this century in assists with 70. Sergio Llull of Real Madrid is second with 71, and Sergio Rodriguez of Real Madrid is the leader with 76.

Sloukas is second in Final Fours this century in accumulated PIR with 204. Victor Khryapa is the leader with 208.

Sloukas is ranked second in Final Fours this century with 57 free throws made each. Nando De Colo is the leader with 59.

Sloukas ranks fourth in Final Fours this century in scoring with 193 points. JR Holden is third with 194 points and Sergio Rodriguez is second with 209. Sergio Llull is the scoring leader at the Final Fours this century with 213.

Sloukas ranks eighth in Final Fours this century with 38 two-pointers made. Holden is seventh with 39 two-pointers made and Llull is sixth with 40.

Sloukas is tied with Kostas Papanikolaou of Olympiacos Piraeus for 11th place in Final Fours this century with 20 three-point shots made apiece. Jaycee Carroll and David Blue are tied for ninth with 21 triples apiece, while Saras Jasikevicius and Vassilis Spanoulis are tied for seventh with 22 apiece.

Kostas Sloukas is in 13th place in Final Fours this century with 37 defensive rebounds. Milos Teodosic and Mike Batiste are tied for 11th place with 38 defensive rebounds apiece.

Sloukas is tied for 18th place in Final Fours this century with 9 steals. Marko Jaric, Jaka Lakovic and Sergio Rodriguez are tied for 15th with 10 steals apiece.

Sloukas needs 1 rebound to enter the top 20 in rebounding in Final Fours this century.

Game notes: Olympiacos Piraeus vs Panathinaikos AKTOR Athens

- Olympiacos held off Panathinaikos 89-94 in Round 8, and 78-76 in Round 29, making it eight straight wins in EuroLeague games against the Greens.
- This season these two archrivals have met four times outside the EuroLeague. Panathinaikos beat Olympiacos in the Greek Cup finals in February and the Greens swept Olympiacos in their two Greek League meetings. Meanwhile, Olympiacos beat Panathinaikos in the Greek Super Cup in September.
- Alec Peters earned MVP of the Round honors in Olympiacos's 78-88 overtime road win over Panathinaikos in Round 1 last season, posting a career-high PIR of 31. He also had a career-best 4 steals in that game.
- Thomas Walkup had career highs in PIR (32) and assists (13), along with 11 points, 7 rebounds and 4 steals, in Olympiacos's 81-73 home win over Panathinaikos in March 2023. Walkup earned MVP of the Round honors for that performance.
- Olympiacos has won the last five times it visited Panathinaikos in EuroLeague games. Meanwhile, the last time Panathinaikos won in Piraeus was in February 2021.
- Panathinaikos and Olympiacos met in the 1994 EuroLeague semifinals in Tel Aviv, Israel, which was their first showdown in European competition. The Reds won 77-72 behind Zarko Paspalj's 22 points.
- Panathinaikos and Olympiacos returned to the Final Four in 1995 and squared off in the semifinals in Zaragoza, Spain. Olympiacos prevailed again, defeating Panathinaikos 52-58 behind 27 points from Eddie Johnson.
- Olympiacos swept Panathinaikos in the 1997 EuroLeague Playoffs in a best-of-three series before later going on to win the EuroLeague title.
- Panathinaikos and Olympiacos played each other in the 2009 EuroLeague Semifinals in Berlin, Germany. In a game that came down to the final shot, Panathinaikos edged Olympiacos 82-84 behind 20 points from Nikola Pekovic.
- Tyrese Rice set a Panathinaikos record with 41 points when the Greens beat Olympiacos 99-93 in overtime at home in December 2019.
- Panathinaikos guard Kostas Sloukas arrived from archrival Olympiacos in the summer of 2023 after spending three years with the Reds, during which he helped the team to back-to-back Final Four appearances, including the 2023 championship game. That was his second stint with Olympiacos. During the first, Sloukas helped Olympiacos win EuroLeague crowns in 2012 and 2013. Sloukas spent five seasons in Piraeus during his first stint with the club, with which he made his debut as a teenager in 2009. He won those titles with one current Olympiacos player: Kostas Papanikolaou.
- Panathinaikos forward Ioannis Papapetrou spent five seasons with Olympiacos, his first professional team, from 2013 to 2018. He played in 114 EuroLeague games for the Reds and reached the EuroLeague Championship Game in 2015 and 2017. He was a teammate of Kostas Papanikolaou and also played under Olympiacos head coach Georgios Bartzokas for one season.

Game notes: Olympiacos Piraeus vs Panathinaikos AKTOR Athens

- Olympiacos's Kostas Papanikolaou, Thomas Walkup and Giannoulis Larentzakis have been teammates of Panathinaikos trio Ioannis Papapetrou, Konstantinos Mitoglou and Dimitris Moraitis on the Greek national team.
- Sloukas and Panagiotis Kalaitzakis have also been teammates on the Greek national team with Papanikolaou and Larentzakis.
- Walkup and Panathinaikos guard Marius Grigonis were backcourt mates at Zalgiris Kaunas for three seasons, from 2018 to 2021.
- Olympiacos center Nikola Milutinov and Grigonis were teammates at CSKA Moscow during the 2021- 2022 season.
- Olympiacos forward Sasha Vezenkov was a teammate of Panathinaikos big man Konstantinos Mitoglou at Aris Thessaloniki during the 2013-14 season.
- Olympiacos forward Alec Peters played under current Panathinaikos head coach Ergin Ataman at Anadolu Efes Istanbul during the 2019-20 season.
- Luca Vildoza played for Panathinaikos last season and helped it win the 2024 EuroLeague crown.
- Vildoza made a career-high 5 three-pointers while playing for Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz against Panathinaikos in November 2020.
- Olympiacos guard Evan Fournier and Panathinaikos center Mathias Lessort have been teammates on the French national team. They won the silver medal at the 2024 Paris Olympics together.
- Olympiacos center Moustapha Fall has also been a teammate of Panathinaikos center Mathias Lessort on the French national team.
- Nikola Milutinov had 18 points, 18 rebounds and a career-high PIR of 41 to earn weekly MVP honors in a 79-65 win over Panathinaikos in January 2019.
- Sloukas had a career-high 4 steals while playing for Fenerbahce against Olympiacos in January 2020.
- Panathinaikos forward Konstantinos Mitoglou tied his career high with 16 rebounds and set his career high with 14 defensive rebounds in a road loss against Olympiacos in March of last season.
- Olympiacos guard Thomas Walkup made a career-best 5 three-pointers in a 78-88 overtime road win over Panathinaikos in October 2023.
- Olympiacos guard Keenan Evans earned MVP of the Round honors while playing for Zalgiris Kaunas against Panathinaikos AKTOR Athens in February 2024. He finished the game with 24 points on 5-of-6 two-pointers, 4-of-5 three-pointers and 2-of-2 free throws. Evans added 3 rebounds, 5 assists, a career-high 5 steals to amass a PIR of 35.
- Panathinaikos point guard Lorenzo Brown made a career-high 11 two-pointers while playing for Crvena Zvezda Belgrade against Olympiacos in December 2019.

Game notes: Olympiacos Piraeus vs Panathinaikos AKTOR Athens

- Olympiacos guard Tyler Dorsey posted his career highs in assists (7) and steals (4) while playing for Maccabi Tel Aviv against Panathinaikos in December 2019.
- Olympiacos guard Shaquille McKissic had a career-best 6 assists in a win over Panathinaikos in March 2022.
