

Streaks

Mike James has made at least 1 three-point shot in 16 straight games. James has had 5 or more assists in eight of his last nine games. James has scored at least 16 points and had PIRs of 19 or more in six of his last seven games. Matthew Strazel has made at least 1 three-pointer in 10 of his last 11 games. Alpha Diallo has scored in double figures in seven of his last eight games. Diallo has made at least 1 three-pointer in five of his last six games. Georgios Papagiannis has made 15 consecutive free throws. Jaron Blossomgame has pulled down multiple offensive rebounds in four of his last five games.

Season rankings

Mike James finished the regular season ranked fourth in assists with 5.7 per game.

Georgios Papagiannis was the regular-season leader in blocks with 1.4 per game.

Mike James ranked third in the 2025 EuroLeague Playoffs in PIR with an average of 19.0.

James ranked fifth in the 2025 EuroLeague Playoffs with 2.4 three-pointers made per game.

James was the 2025 EuroLeague Playoffs leader with 6.6 assists per game.

Monaco has committed 10.8 turnovers per game, the second-lowest in the league.

Monaco ranks fourth in scoring with 86.2 points per game.

Monaco ranks fourth in blocks with 2.8 per game.

Monaco has forced a league-high 13.6 turnovers per game.

Records/Milestones

Mike James is the EuroLeague's all-time leading scorer with 5,259 career points.

James is second all-time with 5,427 index rating points. Nando De Colo of LDLC ASVEL Villeurbanne is first with a PIR of 5,473.

James is in second place all-time in free throws made with 1,159. De Colo is the all-time leader with 1,181.

James is in fifth place all-time with 1,518 career assists. Vassilis Spanoulis is fourth with 1,607 assists.

James is tied with Scottie Wilbekin of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul in fourt place all-time with 608 three-pointers made. Sergio Rodriguez is third with 609 three-pointers.

James is fourth all-time in two-point shots made with 1,138. Georgios Printezis is third with 1,194.

James is in seventh place all-time with 333 career steals. Theo Papaloukas is sixth with 335 career steals.

Nick Calathes is the EuroLeague's all-time leader in assists with 2,133.

Calathes set the EuroLeague single-season assists record in 2018-19 with 286.

Calathes is the EuroLeague's all-time leader in steals with 460.

Calathes ranks second all-time in games started with 318, behind only Kostas Papanikolaou, who has 339 and counting.

Calathes ranks eighth all-time with a 2.6-to-1 career assist-to-turnover ratio.

Calathes is ninth all-time with 4,297 performance index rating points. Kyle Hines is in eighth place all-time with 4,299 performance index rating points.

Calathes is ranked 16th all-time in scoring with 3,284 points. Kyle Hines is 15th with 3,339 points.

Calathes is in 11th place all-time with 1,010 two-pointers made. Paulius Jankunas is 10th with 1,011.

Georgios Papagiannis is ranked fourth all-time with 253 blocks. Kyle Hines is third with 320 blocks.

Papagiannis ranks 17th all-time in two-point accuracy at 64.4%.

Donatas Motiejunas set the EuroLeague single-game record with 18 defensive rebounds on December 7, 2011, while playing for Asseco Prokom Gdynia against Union Olimpija Ljubljana. In that game, Motiejunas pulled down 21 rebounds, the most rebounds in a single game by any active player.

Nick Calathes ranks fifth in Final Fours this century in assists with 51. Theo Papaloukas is fourth with 59 assists.

Calathes is tied with Ante Tomic and Sasha Vezenkov for 15th place in Final Fours this century with 32 defensive rebounds. Rudy Fernandez is in 14th place with 36 defensive rebounds.

Calathes is tied with Felipe Reyes for 18th place in Final Fours this century with 44 rebounds. Dimitris Diamantidis and Trajan Langdon are tied for 16th with 45 rebounds apiece.

Calathes is tied with Shaquielle McKissic in 12th place in Final Fours this century with 12 steals. Mike Batiste, Kyle Hines and Nikola Mirotic are all tied for ninth place with 13 steals apiece.

Calathes has 9 starts in Final Four games this century, which is tied for 13th. Seven players are tied for sixth with 10 games started each.

Streaks

Nigel Hayes-Davis has made at least 1 triple in 43 straight games. Hayes-Davis has posted a PIR of 10 or more in 11 straight games. Hayes-Davis has scored 14 or more points in seven of his last eight games. Hayes-Davis had at least 1 steal in five of his last six games. Hayes-Davis has made 12 consecutive free throws. Wade Baldwin has posted a PIR in double figures in eight straight games. Baldwin has scored 10 or more points in six of his last seven games. Bonzie Colson has made at least 1 three-pointer in seven of his last eight games. Tarik Biberovic has made at least 1 three-pointer in six straight and eight of his last nine games. Biberovic has scored in double figures and had a double-digit PIR in five straight games.

Nigel Hayes-Davis finished the regular season ranked ninth in average index rating with 17.8 per game.

Hayes-Davis finished the regular season ranked eighth in scoring with 16.8 points per game.

Hayes-Davis finished the regular season ranked eighth in steals with 1.1 per game.

Hayes-Davis finished the regular season tied for sixth in three-pointers made with 2.5 per game.

Nigel Hayes-Davis ranked second in the 2025 EuroLeague Playoffs with 21.7 average PIR.

Tarik Biberovic ranked first in the 2025 EuroLeague Playoffs with 3.7 three-pointers made per game.

Fenerbahce ranks third in free-throw shooting at 81.8%.

Fenerbahce ranks third in rebounding with 35.6 per game.

Fenerbahce ranks third in offensive rebounding with 11.7 per game.

Fenerbahce ranks second with 11.3 three-pointers made per game.

Fenerbahce has held opponents to 9.9 offensive rebounds, which is the second-lowest in the league.

Fenerbahce has allowed 80.9 points per game, which is the third-fewest in the league.

Nigel Hayes-Davis set the EuroLeague single-game scoring record with 50 points in a victory over ALBA Berlin in Round 32 last season.

Nicolo Melli is in sixth place all-time in rebounds with 1,643. Jan Vesely of FC Barcelona is fifth with 1,780.

Melli is in second place all-time in defensive rebounds with 1,226. Paulius Jankunas is the all-time leader with 1,453 defensive rebounds.

Melli is in 15th place all-time with 162 career blocks. Mirza Begic is 14th with 163 blocks.

Scottie Wilbekin is tied with Mike James in fourth place all-time with 608 three-pointers made. Sergio Rodriguez is third with 609.

Marko Guduric ranks 20th all-time with 385 three-pointers made. Gianluca Basile is 19th with 421.

Wilbekin is in 14th place all-time with 282 steals. Melli is 13th with 286. Kyle Hines is 12th all-time with 287 career steals.

Wilbekin needs 16 rebounds to reach 500 for his career.

Melli needs 24 points to reach 2,500 for his career.

Sertac Sanli needs 7 rebounds to reach 500 for his career.

Devon Hall needs 2 rebounds to reach 300 for his career.

Sertac Sanli is tied for 19th place in Final Fours this century with 5 blocks.



Game notes: AS Monaco vs Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul

- This is a rematch of last year's playoff series which saw Fenerbahce make history by becoming the first-ever team to win Game 5 on the road, triumphing 79-80 after overtime.

- Monaco swept Fenerbahce in the regular season, including a 69-99 win in Istanbul. It was Fenerbahce's fourth-highest home losing margin in EuroLeague history.

- Fenerbahce's Nigel Hayes-Davis had 19 points and earned MVP of the Round honors with a PIR of 23 when Fenerbahce pulled out a 91-95 overtime road win over Monaco in Game 1 of the 2024 playoffs.

- Fenerbahce and Monaco never played an official game before the 2021-22 season.

- Monaco's Nick Calathes and Georgios Papagiannis arrived from Fenerbahce this past summer. Calathes spent the last two seasons there and Papagiannis played with Fenerbahce last season.

- Calathes played under Fenerbahce head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius not only last season at Fenerbahce but also for two seasons at FC Barcelona, from 2020 to 2022.

- Head coaches Vasilis Spanoulis and Sarunas Jasikevicius were teammates at Panathinaikos Athens, where they won the 2009 EuroLeague title together.

- Fenerbahce forward Bonzie Colson earned co-MVP of the Round honors with a PIR of 34 while playing for Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv in a 93-83 win over Monaco in January 2024.

- Fenerbahce's Nigel Hayes-Davis tied his career high in two-pointers made with 9 in a home loss against Monaco in Round 15.

- Alpha Diallo scored a career-high 24 points in Monaco's home 92-78 win over Fenerbahce in February 2022.

- Tarik Biberovic posted a career-high 8 rebounds in a home loss against Monaco in Game 4 of last season's playoffs.

- Wade Baldwin tied his personal best with 8 rebounds while playing for Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv against Monaco in a Game 3 loss in the 2023 EuroLeague Playoffs.

- Mike James has made a career-best 6 triples twice in his career against Fenerbahce; first for AX Armani Exchange Milan in December 2018 and then for CSKA Moscow in November 2019.

- James dropped 31 points on Fenerbahce in November 2019 while playing for CSKA Moscow in an 88-70 win. James's scoring total saw him hit a career-best 6-of-8 three-pointers and 9-of-9 free throws as he accumulated a performance index rating of 38. He earned MVP of the Round honors for his performance.

- Scottie Wilbekin set career highs in points (37) and PIR (37) while playing for Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv against Monaco in November 2021. He won MVP of the Round honors for that performance in a 95-84 win.
