### Game notes: Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade vs Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul

Crvena Zvezda mts Belgrade vs. Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul

· Fenerbahce has enjoyed dominance over Zvezda, winning nine of their 11 games this century - and all six on its home floor,

including a 77-63 victory in Round 1 behind 17 points from Lorenzo Brown.

· Lorenzo Brown made his EuroLeague debut with Crvena Zvezda last season. He was a teammate of the majority of the players on the current Zvezda roster.

· Last season in Belgrade, Zvezda beat Fenerbahce 68-56 behind 13 points and 6 assists from Lorenzo Brown.

 $\cdot$  Zvezda's single-game record for three-pointers made is 5, which Marko Simonovic tied against Fenerbahce on December 11,

2015.

• Fenerbahce swingman Marko Guduric played two seasons at Crvena Zvezda, from 2015 to 2017. He made his EuroLeague debut there and won two Adriatic League and two Serbian League titles as well as one Serbian Cup. He played under Coach Dejan Radonjic and was a teammate of Branko Lazic, Ognjen Dobric, Borisa Simanic and Ognjan Kuzmic.

• Guduric, Kuzmic and Lazic also teamed up on the Serbian national team and won silver medals at EuroBasket 2017.

· Zvezda's Marko Simonovic, Borisa Simanic and Aleksa Radanov played under Fenerbahce head coach Igor Kokoskov on the Serbian national team.

• Fenerbahce forward Danilo Barthel played under current Zvezda head coach Dejan Radonjic as a team captain at FC Bayern Munich for almost two full seasons. Together they won back-to-back German League titles in 2018 and 2019.

• Fenerbahce guard Ali Muhammed posted his career-high in assists with 11 against Crvena Zvezda in a 65-88 road win in January 2016.

Muhammed tied his career-high with 7 three-pointers made in a 63-80 road win over Crvena Zvezda in March 2018.




Zvezda forward Dejan Davidovac posted career-highs in performance index rating (25) and points (18) against Fenerbahce in March 2018.

In their meeting in Berlin last season, Luke Sikma set a career-high with 12 rebounds and Niels Giffey tied his career-best with 3 steals.



· Zenit veteran swingman K.C. Rivers returns to Athens where he played for Panathinaikos from 2016 to 2018. He made 64 EuroLeague appearances for the Greens and averaged a career-best 11.2 points in 2016-17.

· Panathinaikos guard Nemanja Nedovic and Zenit forward Will Thomas were teammates at Unicaja Malaga during the 2015-16 season.

· Zenit center Arturas Gudaitis and Milan guard Nemanja Nedovic were teammates the last two seasons at AX Armani Exchange Milan.

• Panathinaikos center lan Vougioukas and Khimki forward Andrey Zubkov were teammates at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2016-17 season.

Panathinaikos forward Aaron White played at Zenit during the 2016-17 season. He was a teammate there of Anton Pushkov.
 White and Zenit point guard Kevin Pangos were teammates with Zalgiris Kaunas during the 2017-18 season. They helped Zalgiris reach the 2018 Final Four.

· Zenit's Alex Poythress and Panathinaikos's Zach Auguste were frontcourt mates at Galatasaray Istanbul last season.

Zenit sharpshooter Vitaly Fridzon set his career-high with 7 assists playing for Khimki Moscow Region against Panathinaikos in December 2009.

· Zenit center Arturas Gudaitis matched his career-high in scoring with 20 points in an 83-86 road win for AX Armani Exchange Milan over Panathinaikos in December 2018.

## Game facts: Real Madrid

### Roster

Thirteen different players have started for Real so far this season. No player has started every game. Anthony Randolph is out with a ruptured left Achilles tendon.

#### Streaks

Trey Thompkins has made 15 consecutive free throws. Walter Tavares has blocked a shot in 10 straight games. Tavares has posted a PIR in double figures in eight of his last nine games. Tavares has scored in double figures in five of his last six games. Nicolas Laprovittola has made 13 consecutive free throws. Sergio Llull has at least 1 steal in six of his last seven games.

#### Rankings

Walter Tavares ranks fifth this season in average PIR with 19.0 per game. Tavares ranks second this season with 7.8 rebounds per game and second in offensive rebounding with 3.2 per game. Tavares leads the league with 1.9 blocks per game this season.

Felipe Reyes is second on the EuroLeague's career charts in games played with 353.

Reyes is the EuroLeague career leader in offensive rebounds with 702.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 1,793 total rebounds. Paulius Jankunas of Zalgiris is the all-time leader with 1,875 and counting. Reyes ranks third all-time with 1,091 defensive rebounds. His former teammate loannis Bourousis is second with 1,164.

Reyes ranks fifth all-time with 3,769 index rating points. Dimitris Diamantidis is fourth with 3,806. Reves ranks ranked fifth all-time with 969 two-point shots made. Paulius Jankunas is fourth with 983 and counting.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 964 free throws made. Vassilis Spanoulis of Olympiacos is the all-time leader with 1,116.

Next time he enters the game, Sergio Llull will make his 300th appearance in the competition.

Llull is fifth all-time with 3,127 points in his career; Felipe Reyes ranks seventh all-time with 3,022 points.

## Game notes: Real Madrid vs AX Armani Exchange Milan

Real Madrid vs. AX Armani Exchange Milan

• Real holds a 15-2 edge in head-to-head games, but Milan won their Round 4 clash 78-70 to snap a 14-game losing streak that dated back to 2009.

• Milan guard Sergio Rodriguez shined in their Round 4 game, collecting 25 points, 7 assists and 4 rebounds for a career-high PIR 37.

· Last year in the Spanish capital, Real downed Milan 76-67 with Anthony Randolph collecting 16 points plus 7 rebounds.

• In 1964, Real Madrid and Simmenthal Milano faced each other in the two-game semifinals. Real Madrid bounced back from a 5-point loss in Game 1 to beat Milan 101-78 at Fronton Fiesta Alegre in the Spanish capital. Emiliano Rodriguez scored 31 points for Madrid and Clifford Luyk added 28. Real Madrid went on to win its first continental title.

In the 1967 European Cup final played in Madrid - under a Final Four format for just the second time, and the last until the format became the standard in 1988, Real Madrid downed Simmenthal Milan 91-83 behind 29 points from Emiliano Rodriguez. 
 Real Madrid and Milan met in the 1984 Cup Winners' Cup title game played in Ostend, Belgium. It came down to the final seconds, in which Brian Jackson drew a foul and sank both free throws to lift Real Madrid past Simac Milan 82-81. Jackson was the top scorer with 27 points.

• Milan head coach Ettore Messina spent just short of two seasons on the Real bench, from 2009 to 2011. He had a 23-13 record in those two seasons in EuroLeague games. Current Real players Felipe Reyes and Sergio Llull both played under Messina in that period.

Milan guard Sergio Rodriguez played for Real Madrid from 2010 to 2016 and in those six seasons made four Final Four appearances, won the 2015 title and was named 2014 EuroLeague MVP. He was a teammate of current Real players Sergio Llull and Felipe Reyes for the entire time there, played five seasons under Coach Pablo Laso and was a teammate for five seasons with Rudy Fernandez and Jaycee Carroll. Rodriguez also played alongside Trey Thompkins and Jeffery Taylor during his years in Madrid.
 Milan guard Michael Roll was a teammate of Real guard Fabien Causeur at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz, briefly, at the end of the 2015-16 season.

Real center Walter Tavares led Real to a 73-78 comeback victory in Milan last season with 13 points, 12 rebounds and 4 blocks. Tavares accumulated a performance index rating of 29 to earn MVP of the Round 27 honors.

/ Real Madrid's injured forward Anthony Randolph was a teammate of Milan's Malcolm Delaney at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2015-16 season. They reached the EuroLeague Final Four together.

/In the 2018-19 season, Real rallied from a 15-point deficit to beat Milan 85-91 as Anthony Randolph paced the winners with 25 points and 11 rebounds; his PIR of 33 earned him co-MVP of the Round honors.

Randolph pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds in Real's 90-101 win in Milan in October 2016.

· Earlier this season in Round 4, Real's Usman Garuba posted a career-high 11 rebounds versus Milan.

Real swingman Alberto Abalde scored a career-high 21 points playing for Valencia Basket against Milan in March of last season.
 Real forward Trey Thompkins matched his career-high with 15 rebounds playing for Nizhny Novgorod against Milan in January 2015.

· Milan guard Michael Roll had career-highs of 23 points, PIR 26 and 3 steals playing for Maccabi Tel Aviv against Real Madrid in January 2019.
