## Game notes: CSKA Moscow vs Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv

CSKA Moscow vs. Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv

- · CSKA has an 18-8 record against Maccabi this century, but Maccabi has won their last two head-to-head games, including a 90-80 victory in December last season in which Scottie Wilbekin scored 22 points, dished a career-best 9 assists and added 5 rebounds and 3 steals, while Othello Hunter collected a career-high 20 points with 7 rebounds.
- The last time these teams played in Moscow was in January 2019 when Maccabi stormed to a 76-93 road win, thus ending a streak of nine consecutive road losses in Moscow which dated back to 2004. Maccabi set a single-game club record in two-pointers made with 35 in that game.
- $\cdot$  Maccabi and CSKA met in the 2001 SuproLeague semifinals; Maccabi beat CSKA 86-80 behind 17 points each from Arriel McDonald and Nate Huffman and went on to win the title.
- · Maccabi and CSKA played against each other in the 2004 EuroLeague Final Four semifinal in Tel Aviv, Israel. Maccabi topped CSKA 93-85 to advance to the final behind Anthony Parker, who shined with 27 points.
- · Maccabi and CSKA dueled in the 2006 EuroLeague championship game in Prague, where CSKA won 73-69 thanks to 18 points from Final Four MVP Theo Papaloukas.
- · Maccabi and CSKA met again in the 2008 EuroLeague title game in Madrid. CSKA defeated Maccabi 91-77 as Final Four MVP Trajan Langdon took over with 21 points.
- · In the 2014 Turkish Airlines EuroLeague semifinals in Milan, Maccabi edged CSKA 67-68 on a steal and late basket by Tyrese Rice. Maccabi went on to win the EuroLeague title and Rice earned Final Four MVP honors.
- · Maccabi set a club record for three-throw accuracy when it made 21 shots from the line without a miss against CSKA in December 2016.
- · Maccabi center Othello Hunter played at CSKA Moscow for two seasons between 2017 and 2019. He helped the team win the 2019 EuroLeague title.
- · CSKA forward Will Clyburn and Maccabi's Scottie Wilbekin and Ante Zizic were teammates at Darussafaka Istanbul during the 2016-17 season. They helped the team reach the EuroLeague Playoffs.
- CSKA center Nikola Milutinov played under current Maccabi head coach Ioannis Sfairopoulos during his tenure with Olympiacos, for three seasons from 2015 to 2018. They reached the 2017 championship game together.
- / Janis Strelnieks of CSKA played under Coach Sfairopoulos during the 2017-18 season at Olympiacos Piraeus.
- · Strelnieks scored a career-high 25 points shooting a career-best 5-for-5 from three-point range while playing for Brose Bamberg against Maccabi in February 2017.
- · CSKA big man Tornike Shengelia set his career highs with 31 points and 6 three-pointers made playing for Baskonia against Maccabi in November of last season.
- · Maccabi guard Scottie Wilbekin set career-highs with 9 assists and a PIR of 33 in a 90-80 home win over CSKA in December 2019. Wilbekin made a career-high 8 three-pointers playing for Darussafaka against CSKA in March 2017.
- · CSKA big man Johannes Voigtmann set his career-highs in points (23) and steals (3) while playing for Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz in a 101-88 win over Maccabi in December 2016.
- · CSKA's Darrun Hilliard set his career-high with a PIR of 23 playing for Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz against Maccabi in January 2019.
- · Maccabi's Yovel Zoosman had a career game in his team's 76-93 road win against CSKA last season, scoring a career-high 15 points and posting his career-high in index rating with 22.
- · The last time Maccabi hosted CSKA, Angelo Caloiaro scored a career-high 21 points in an 86-89 home loss in October 2018.



Mirotic has posted a performance index rating of 13 or more in each of his last 32 appearances dating back to the 2014 EuroLeague Playoffs.

Mirotic has made at least 1 three-pointer in eight of his last nine EuroLeague games.

Mirotic has collected at least 1 steal in eight of his last nine games.

Victor Claver has made 14 consecutive free throws dating back to the 2018-19 season.

Zenit St Petersburg vs. FC Barcelona

- · Zenit played its first-ever EuroLeague home game against Barcelona last season. Barcelona raced to a 63-87 win behind a career-high 24 points from Kyle Kuric.
- · Barcelona's Victor Claver was a teammate of Zenit forward Andrey Zubkov during the 2015-16 season at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar. They helped Lokomotiv reach the EuroLeague Final Four.
- $\cdot$  Zenit guard Kevin Pangos spent the last two seasons with Barcelona. He was a teammate with the majority of players on Barcelona's roster.
- · Zenit big man Arturas Gudaitis was a teammate of Barcelona head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius at Zalgiris Kaunas during the 2013-14 season. A season later the two were still together at Zalgiris, but Jasikevicius became the team's assistant coach.
- · Barcelona guard Kyle Kuric played for Zenit during the 2017-18 season when he was the EuroCup Top 16 MVP and an All-EuroCup Second Team selection. He was a teammate of Anton Pushkov.
- · Zenit head coach Xavi Pascual faces Barcelona, a team he coached from 2008 until 2016. In those seven-plus seasons, he guided the club to 19 trophies, highlighted by the 2010 EuroLeague title.
- $\cdot$  Barcelona point guard Nick Calathes played under Zenit head coach Xavi Pascual at Panathinaikos Athens for more than two years between 2016 and 2018.
- · Zenit's Pangos, Barcelona big man Davies and Coach Sarunas Jasikevicius joined together at Zalgiris Kaunas in leading the team to the 2018 Final Four. Pangos also played under Coach Jasikevicius in the 2016-17 season.
- · Barcelona's Pierre Oriola and Zenit's Will Thomas were teammates at Valencia Basket during the 2016-17 season. They won the Spanish League together.
- · Barcelona center Brandon Davies set his career-high in assists with 6 in a 63-87 win in St. Petersburg last season.
- In that same game, Barcelona sharpshooter Kyle Kuric posted his career-high in index rating with 26 and set a career-high with 26 points.

#### ALBA Berlin vs. FC Bayern Munich

- · In their only head-to-head EuroLeague meeting last season, Bayern pulled out a 76-77 overtime win in Berlin behind Vladimir Lucic who scored all of his 19 points in the second half and overtime.
- · ALBA had 6 blocks to set the club record in EuroLeague play this century when it hosted Bayern in Berlin last season.
- $\cdot$  ALBA point guard Maodo Lo arrived from Bayern this summer, where he played the past two seasons and made 57 appearances in the EuroLeague.
- · Bayern's Nihad Dedovic, Leon Radosevic and Alex King played have at ALBA in the past. Dedovic spent the 2012-13 season in Berlin, Radosevic was there in 2014-15 and King played for ALBA for three seasons, from 2013 to 2016. King and Radosevic were teammates of current ALBA player Niels Giffey.
- $\cdot$  ALBA's Louis Olinde and Lo made their respective EuroLeague debuts under current Bayern coach Andrea Trinchieri at Brose Bamberg in the 2016-17 season. They were also together for the first part of the 2017-18 season.
- · Lo and Olinde were also teammates with Radosevic at Bamberg from 2016 to 2018.
- · ALBA's Luke Sikma and Bayern's Vladimir Lucic were teammates at Valencia Basket during the 2015-16 season.
- · ALBA's Niels Giffey, Maodo Lo and Johannes Thiemann and Bayern's Paul Zipser have been teammates on the German national team.
- · Bayern big man Jalen Reynolds posted his career-high in index rating with 21 and in scoring with 17 points for Maccabi Tel Aviv against ALBA last season in January.

- $\cdot$  In their lone EuroLeague meeting this century, ASVEL downed Milan 89-82 last season at home behind 19 points from David Lighty.
- $\cdot$  ASVEL's David Lighty was a teammate of Milan's Vladimir Micov and Andrea Cinciarini at Cantu for part of the 2011-12 season. Lighty and Cinciarini made their respective EuroLeague debuts that season.
- $\cdot$  Milan sharpshooter Michael Roll and ASVEL point guard Norris Cole were teammates at Maccabi Tel Aviv during the 2017-18 season.
- · ASVEL's Paul Lacombe set a career-high with 13 points for Strasbourg against Milan in December 2013.
- · ASVEL guard Antoine Diot matched his career-high in steals with 4 playing for Strasbourg against Milan in December 2013.
