### Game facts: Anadolu Efes Istanbul

### Roster

Coach Ergin Ataman has used 13 different players in his starting lineups so far this season. No player has started every game. The next time Chris Singleton enters the game he will appear in his 200th game. Singleton has never sat out of a EuroLeague game and his 199 appearances in five seasons in the competition is the longest active streak and the third-longest in the EuroLeague alltime.

#### Streaks

Vasilije Micic has made at least 1 three-pointer in five of his last six games. Shane Larkin has made at least 1 three-point shot in 20 of his last 21 games.

Rodrigue Beaubois has made at least one three-point shot in 21 of his last 22 appearances. Beaubois has scored in double figures in five straight and 13 of his last 14 games.

#### Rankings

Vasilije Micic ranks fourth in scoring this season with 16.2 points per game; Shane Larkin is 10th with 15.2.

Larkin ranks ninth this season in average PIR with 17.2 per game. Micic ranks 10th with 17.0.

Larkin ranks fifth in the EuroLeague Playoffs in average PIR with 18.0 per game.

Rodrigue Beaubois ranks fourth in scoring in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 17.8 points per game, and Micic is fifth with 17.0 points per game.

Micic ranks ninth this season with 4.8 assists per game.

Larkin ranks second in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 5.0 assists per game.

Larkin ranks ninth in steals this season with 1.3 per game.

Larkin ranks fourth this season with 2.6 three-point shots made per game.

Micic leads the EuroLeague Playoffs with 3.3 three-point shots made per game, Beaubois is tied for second with 3.0 per game, and Larkin is sixth with 2.5 per game.

Beaubois ranks seventh this season in three-point accuracy at 49.3%.

Sertac Sanli ranks 10th in the EuroLeague in two-point accuracy this season at 67.3%.

### **Records/Milestones**

Shane Larkin set the EuroLeague all-time single-game scoring record with 49 points in a Round 11 win over FC Bayern Munich last season. In that game, he also tied the competition record with 10 three-pointers made.

Larkin knocked down a EuroLeague-record-tying 10 triples against Olympiacos Piraeus in Round 28 last season, when he scored 40 points, becoming the first player this century to score 40 or more points twice in his career.

Bryant Dunston is the all-time leader in blocked shots with 273.

Dunston is tied with Nikola Milutinov of CSKA for eighth place in EuroLeague history with 464 career offensive rebounds. Jan Vesely of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is sixth with 477.

Sertac Sanli ranks fifth all-time in two-point accuracy at 68.1%.

Tibor Pleiss ranks seventh all-time with 182 blocked shots. Ioannis Bourousis is sixth with 194.

Chris Singleton is in 20th place all-time with 125 blocked shots. Ekpe Udoh is in 19th place with 129.

Dogus Balbay needs 3 assists to reach 200 for his career.

James Anderson needs 4 steals to reach 100 for his career.

Adrien Moerman needs 2 three-point shots made to reach 200 for his career.

### Roster

Fifteen different players have started for Real so far this season. No player has started every game.

### Streaks

Walter Tavares has blocked at least 1 shot in nine straight and 15 of his last 16 games. Tavares had double-digit PIRs in nine straight and 12 of his last 13 games. Rudy Fernandez has made at least 1 three-point shot in 14 of his last 15 games. Usman Garuba has blocked at least 1 shot in six of his last seven games. Jaycee Carroll has made 23 consecutive free throws.

### Rankings

Walter Tavares ranks fifth this season in average PIR with 18.3 per game.

Tavares ranks second this season with 8.1 rebounds per game and second in offensive rebounding with 3.3 per game. Tavares is the league leader this season with 1.7 blocks per game.

Usman Garuba leads the EuroLeague Playoffs with 7.3 rebounds per game going into Game 5. Alex Tyus is fifth with 5.7 rebounds per game.

Trey Thompkins is tied for the league lead this season in free-throw accuracy at 94.6%.

Sergio Llull ranks third in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 4.8 assists per game and Nicolas Laprovittola is fifth with 4.5 assists per game.

### **Records/Milestones**

Felipe Reyes is second on the EuroLeague's career charts in games played with 357.

Reyes is the EuroLeague career leader in offensive rebounds with 705.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 1,799 total rebounds.

Reyes ranks third all-time with 1,094 defensive rebounds. His former teammate loannis Bourousis is second with 1,164.

Reyes ranks sixth all-time with 3,775 index rating points. Dimitris Diamantidis is fifth with 3,806.

Reyes ranks sixth all-time with 971 two-point shots made. Paulius Jankunas of Zalgiris Kaunas is fifth with 998.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 967 free throws made.

Sergio Llull is in fifth place all-time with 3,187 points in his career. Reyes ranks eighth all-time with 3,029 points.

Llull ranks sixth all-time with 1,159 assists. Thomas Heurtel is fifth with 1,216.

Llull is in 11th place all-time with 578 free throws made. Ioannis Bourousis is 10th with 581.

Llull ranks fourth all-time with a 2.82-to-1 career assist-to-turnover ratio.

Rudy Fernandez ranks third all-time with 492 three-point shots made. Sergio Llull is fifth with 487. Their former teammate Sergio Rodriguez of AX Armani Exchange Milan is fourth with 490.

Llull is 9 steals away from reaching 200 for his career.

Fernandez ranks fifth all-time with 300 steals. Pablo Prigioni is fourth with 322.

Rudy Fernandez needs 4 assists to reach 700 for his career.

Jaycee Carroll ranks 17th all-time with 2,597 points. Fernandez is 16th with 2,661 points.

Carroll ranks seventh all-time with 437 three-point shots made. Milos Teodosic is sixth with 471.

Carroll ranks fifth all-time in free throw accuracy at 91.1%.

Walter Tavares ranks fourth all-time with 222 blocks. Alex Tyus is fifth with 217.

Tavares ranks fourth all-time in two-point accuracy at 69.5%.

### Game notes: Anadolu Efes Istanbul vs Real Madrid

In Game 3, Real rallied to an 80-76 win after ending the game on a 19-2 run, mounting the biggest late-game comeback for a regulation-time victory in EuroLeague Playoffs history. Sergio Llull paced Real with 20 points and 7 assists in that victory.
In winning the first two games of the series, Efes became just the fourth team to start a best-of-five series with back-to-back 20-point wins. In Game 1, Efes topped Real 90-63 with Rodrigue Beaubois scoring 19 points and Sertac Sanli collecting 16 points plus 8 rebounds. In Game 2, Efes routed Real 91-68 with Vasilije Micic scoring 23 points and Shane Larkin adding 21 points and 5 assists.

• In Round 32 in Madrid, Efes raced away to an 83-108 victory. In that game, Efes scored 67 second-half points, which is the most points Real has allowed in a single half of a EuroLeague game this century.

Real beat Efes 65-73 in Round 17 of the regular season by making 14 triples and Fabien Causeur scoring 15 points.
 Shane Larkin made history last season in Madrid by becoming the first player with a streak of four straight MVP of the Round honors. Larkin powered Efes to a 75-80 road win, piling up 32 points along with 4 assists, 3 rebounds and 2 steals for a performance index rating of 36.

• With that win last season, Efes snapped a streak of 12 consecutive defeats in the Spanish capital, a run that dated back to January 2005.

• Real Madrid ousted Efes with a 3-1 series win in the 2015 EuroLeague Playoffs. Rudy Fernandez averaged 13.5 points, 4.0 assists and 3.3 rebounds in the series.

The Efes single-game record for assists is 15, which Thomas Heurtel set against Real Madrid in April 2015.

• Real's single-game record for three-pointers made is 7, which two different Real players have accomplished. Alberto Herreros hit 7 triples against Efes in April 2002 in Madrid, though Efes won that game 92-109. Real sharpshooter Jaycee Carroll tied the mark by making 7 triples on 8 attempts in a 97-80 victory over Efes in April 2017.

Real Madrid forward Anthony Randolph was a teammate of Efes big man Chris Singleton at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2015-16 season. They reached the EuroLeague Final Four together.

Randolph and Efes guard Krunoslav Simon were teammates at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2014-15 season.

Real guard Fabien Causeur and Efes center Tibor Pleiss were teammates at Baskonia for two seasons, from 2012 to 2014. Real guard Nicolas Laprovittola was a teammate of Efes guards Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin during the second part of

the 2016-17 season at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz.

· Laprovittola matched his career-high with 10 assists in Game 2 of this series.

• Real big man Alex Tyus played at Anadolu Efes during the 2015-16 season. He was a teammate of current Efes players Dogus Balbay and Bryant Dunston.

· Tyus and Efes center Tibor Pleiss were teammates at Galatasaray Istanbul during the 2016-17 season, playing under current Efes head coach Ergin Ataman.

• Tyus had one of his best EuroLeague games playing for Galatasaray against Efes in December 2016. He posted 15 points, 13 rebounds and 3 blocks for a career-high performance index rating of 29.

Efes center Sertac Sanli tied his career-high with 8 rebounds in Game 1 of this series.

Real center Usman Garuba had a career-best 3 blocks in his team's Round 32 loss against Efes.

 Real guard Fabien Causeur had a career-best performance playing for Brose Bamberg against Efes in December 2016. He scored a career-high 28 points and earned the MVP of the Round award with a personal-best performance index rating of 35.
 Real guard Sergio Llull dished a career-high 12 assists against Efes in April 2015.

· Llull set his career-high with 8 rebounds in a 92-84 Real win in January 2019 and tied his career-best with 3 steals in a 66-75 road win over Efes in December 2011.

Real Madrid big man Trey Thompkins set a career-high with 3 blocks playing for Nizhny Novgorod against Efes in November 2014.
 Efes center Bryant Dunston set a career-high with 4 steals in Game 4 against Real.

• Dunston was named the 2013-14 EuroLeague Playoffs Game 3 MVP when he played for Olympiacos Piraeus against Real Madrid. He set a career-high with 21 points and added 9 rebounds and 4 assists for a performance index rating of 32.

• Efes forward James Anderson matched his career-high with 3 steals playing for Darussafaka Istanbul against Real in February 2017.

· Efes forward Adrien Moerman recorded a career-high in index rating of 33 against Real in December 2018.

• Real guard Alberto Abalde dished a career-high 8 assists playing for Valencia Basket against Efes in February 2018. He set a careerhigh with 3 steals for Valencia against Efes in October 2019.

<sup>•</sup> Real has a 25-11 lead in EuroLeague games against Efes after near-identical rallies in Games 3 and 4 to tie the series at 2-2. • Real rallied from a double-digit fourth-quarter deficit, using a 19-2 late-game run to pull out an 82-76 win in Game 4. Usman Garuba posted career highs of 24 points, 12 rebounds and 30 PIR to lead Real, while Jaycee Carroll netted 20 points on 4-for-7 three-point shooting.

• Bayern came back from 13 points down in Game 4 to edge Milan 85-82 and force a deciding Game 5 of their best-of-five EuroLeague Playoff series. Wade Baldwin IV led Bayern with 18 points while Paul Zipser scored all 16 of his points in the final 17 minutes.

 $\cdot$  Bayern held off Milan 85-79 in Game 3, cutting Milan's series lead to 2-1. The victory was not only Bayern's first in the Turkish Airlines EuroLeague Playoffs, but also the first gained by any German team at that stage of the season. Vladimir Lucic was the home team's main inspiration, pairing a career-best 27 points with 7 rebounds.

 $\cdot$  In Game 2, Milan beat Bayern 80-69 with Kevin Punter scoring 20 points.

• In the series opener, Milan pulled out a dramatic 79-78 win on a buzzer-beating alley-oop layup by Zach LeDay, who led the winners with 17 points and 7 rebounds.

· Milan has a 7-5 edge in head-to-head games against Bayern, all played since October 2014. Before Bayern's Game 3 victory, Milan had won five consecutive games.

• Milan swept Bayern in the regular season, which included a 75-51 home win in January. Milan held Bayern to club-record lows with 51 points, 2 three-pointers made, and a team PIR of 32. In their season opener, Milan pulled out a 79-81 overtime win in Munich behind 17 points and 8 assists from Malcolm Delaney.

• Before Milan routed Bayern in Round 21 in January, every time Bayern had visited Milan, the game was decided by a single basket.
