#### Roster

Fifteen different players have started for Real so far this season. No player has started every game.

#### **Streaks**

Walter Tavares has blocked at least 1 shot in nine straight and 15 of his last 16 games.

Tavares had double-digit PIRs in nine straight and 12 of his last 13 games.

Rudy Fernandez has made at least 1 three-point shot in 13 of his last 14 games.

Usman Garuba blocked at least 1 shot in five of his last six games.

# **Rankings**

Walter Tavares ranks fifth this season in average PIR with 18.3 per game.

Tavares ranks second this season with 8.1 rebounds per game and second in offensive rebounding with 3.3 per game.

Tavares leads the EuroLeague Playoffs with 9.0 rebounds per game going into Game 4. Usman Garuba is sixth with 5.7, and Alex Tyus is seventh with 5.5 rebounds per game.

Tavares is the league leader this season with 1.7 blocks per game. Tavares leads the EuroLeague Playoffs with 2.0 blocks per game.

Trey Thompkins is tied for the league lead this season in free-throw accuracy at 94.6%.

Nicolas Laprovittola is tied for second in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 5.0 assists per game.

Reyes ranks sixth all-time with 3,778 index rating points. Dimitris Diamantidis is fifth with 3,806.

Reyes ranks sixth all-time with 971 two-point shots made. Paulius Jankunas of Zalgiris Kaunas is fifth with 998.

Reyes ranks second all-time with 967 free throws made.

Sergio Llull moved into fifth place all-time with 3,179 points in his career. Reyes ranks eighth all-time with 3,029 points.

Llull ranks sixth all-time with 1,151 assists. Thomas Heurtel is fifth with 1,216.

Llull is in 12th place all-time with 574 free throws made. Alexey Shved of Khimki Moscow Region is 11th with 577.

Llull ranks fourth all-time with a 2.81-to-1 career assist-to-turnover ratio.

Rudy Fernandez ranks third all-time with 490 three-point shots made. Sergio Llull is fifth with 487. Their former teammate Sergio Rodriguez of AX Armani Exchange Milan is fourth with 489.

Llull is 9 steals away from reaching 200 for his career.

Fernandez needs 2 steals to reach 300 for his career. He ranks fifth all-time. Pablo Prigioni is fourth with 322.

Rudy Fernandez needs 5 assists to reach 700 for his career.

Jaycee Carroll ranks 17th all-time with 2,577 points. Fernandez is 16th with 2,653 points.

Carroll ranks seventh all-time with 433 three-point shots made. Milos Teodosic is sixth with 471.

Carroll ranks sixth all-time in free throw accuracy at 90.96%.

Walter Tavares ranks fourth all-time with 222 blocks. Alex Tyus is fifth with 217.

Tavares ranks fourth all-time in two-point accuracy at 69.5%.



# Game facts: Anadolu Efes Istanbul

#### Roster

Coach Ergin Ataman has used 13 different players in his starting lineups so far this season. No player has started every game. Chris Singleton has never sat out of a EuroLeague game. He has made 198 appearances in five seasons in the competition, which is the longest active streak and the third-longest in the EuroLeague all-time.

#### **Streaks**

Vasilije Micic had a PIR of at least 12 in 12 of his last 13 games.

Larkin has made at least 1 three-point shot in 19 of his last 20 games.

Rodrigue Beaubois has made at least one three-point shot in 20 of his last 21 appearances.

# Rankings

Vasilije Micic ranks fourth in scoring this season with 16.4 points per game; Shane Larkin is 10th with 15.0.

Micic ranks ninth this season in average PIR with 17.4 per game. Larkin ranks 10th with 16.7.

Micic ranks third in the EuroLeague Playoffs in average PIR with 21.7 per game, and third in scoring with 19.7 points per game.

Micic ranks eighth this season with 4.9 assists per game.

Micic is tied for fourth in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 4.7 assists per game.

Larkin ranks ninth in steals this season with 1.3 per game.

Micic is tied for second in steals in the EuroLeague Playoffs with 1.7 per game.

Larkin ranks fifth this season with 2.6 three-point shots made per game.

Micic leads the EuroLeague Playoffs with 3.7 three-point shots made per game, and Larkins is tied for sixth with 2.3 per game going into Game 4.

Sertac Sanli ranks 10th in the EuroLeague in two-point accuracy this season at 67.3%.

Rodrigue Beaubois is tied for fourth in the league this season in free-throw accuracy at 94.3%.

Beaubois ranks eighth this season in three-point accuracy at 48.4%.

#### **Records/Milestones**

Shane Larkin set the EuroLeague all-time single-game scoring record with 49 points in a Round 11 win over FC Bayern Munich last season. In that game, he also tied the competition record with 10 three-pointers made.

Larkin knocked down a EuroLeague-record-tying 10 triples again against Olympiacos Piraeus in Round 28 last season, when he scored 40 points, becoming the first player this century to score 40 or more points twice in his career.

Bryant Dunston is the all-time leader in blocked shots with 271.

Dunston ranks eighth in EuroLeague history with 462 career offensive rebounds. Nikola Milutinov of CSKA Moscow is seventh with 464.

Sertac Sanli ranks fifth all-time in two-point accuracy at 68.1%.

Tibor Pleiss ranks seventh all-time with 182 blocked shots. Ioannis Bourousis is sixth with 194.

Chris Singleton is tied with Gustavo Ayon for 20th place all-time with 124 blocked shots.

Dogus Balbay needs 3 assists to reach 200 for his career.

James Anderson needs 4 steals to reach 100 for his career.

Adrien Moerman needs 2 three-point shots made to reach 200 for his career.



# Game notes: Real Madrid vs Anadolu Efes Istanbul

Real Madrid vs. Anadolu Efes Istanbul

- $\cdot$  Real has a 24-11 lead in EuroLeague games against Efes after rallying to an 80-76 win in Game 3. Real ended the game on a 19-2 run in the final 5 minutes, mounting the biggest late-game comeback for a regulation-time victory in EuroLeague Playoffs history to cut the series deficit to 2-1. Sergio Llull paced Real with 20 points and 7 assists in that victory.
- · In winning the first two games of the series, Efes became just the fourth team to start a best-of-five series with back-to-back 20-point wins. In Game 1, Efes topped Real 90-63 with Rodrigue Beaubois scoring 19 points and Sertac Sanli collecting 16 points plus 8 rebounds. In Game 2, Efes routed Real 91-68 with Vasilije Micic scoring 23 points and Shane Larkin adding 21 points and 5 assists.
- · In Round 32 in Madrid, Efes raced away to an 83-108 victory. In that game, Efes scored 67 second-half points, which is the most points Real has allowed in a single half of a EuroLeague game this century.
- · Real beat Efes 65-73 in Round 17 of the regular season by making 14 triples and with Fabien Causeur scoring 15 points.
- · Shane Larkin made history last season in Madrid by becoming the first player with a streak of four straight MVP of the Round honors. Larkin powered Efes to a 75-80 road win, piling up 32 points along with 4 assists, 3 rebounds and 2 steals for a performance index rating of 36.
- · With that win last season, Efes snapped a streak of 12 consecutive defeats in the Spanish capital, a run that dated back to January 2005.
- $\cdot$  Real Madrid ousted Efes with a 3-1 series win in the 2015 EuroLeague Playoffs. Rudy Fernandez averaged 13.5 points, 4.0 assists and 3.3 rebounds in the series.
- The Efes single-game record for assists is 15, which Thomas Heurtel set against Real Madrid on April 17, 2015.
- Real's single-game record for three-pointers made is 7, which two different Real players have accomplished. Alberto Herreros hit 7 triples against Efes in April 2002 in Madrid, though Efes won that game 92-109. Real sharpshooter Jaycee Carroll tied the mark by making 7 triples on 8 attempts in a 97-80 victory over Efes in April 2017.
- · Real Madrid forward Anthony Randolph, who is injured, was a teammate of Efes big man Chris Singleton at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2015-16 season. They reached the EuroLeague Final Four together.
- · Randolph and Efes guard Krunoslav Simon were teammates at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar during the 2014-15 season.
- Real guard Fabien Causeur and Efes center Tibor Pleiss were teammates at Baskonia for two seasons, from 2012 to 2014.
- $\cdot$  Real guard Nícolas Laprovittola was a teammate of Efes guards Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin during the second part of the 2016-17 season at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz.
- · Laprovittola matched his career-high with 10 assists in Game 2 of this series.
- · Real big man Alex Tyus played at Anadolu Efes during the 2015-16 season. He was a teammate of current Efes players Dogus Balbay and Bryant Dunston.
- · Tyus and Efes center Tibor Pleiss were teammates at Galatasaray Istanbul during the 2016-17 season, playing under current Efes head coach Ergin Ataman.
- · Tyus had one of his best EuroLeague games playing for Galatasaray against Efes in December 2016. He posted 15 points, 13 rebounds and 3 blocks for a career-high performance index rating of 29.
- · Efes center Sertac Sanli tied his career-high with 8 rebounds in Game 1 of this series.
- · Real center Usman Garuba had a career-best 3 blocks in his team's Round 32 loss against Efes.
- Real guard Fabien Causeur had a career-best performance playing for Brose Bamberg against Efes in December 2016. He scored a career-high 28 points and earned the MVP of the Round award with a personal-best performance index rating of 35.
- · Real guard Sergio Llull dished a career-high 12 assists against Efes in April 2015.
- · Llull set his career-high with 8 rebounds in a 92-84 Real win in January 2019 and tied his career-best with 3 steals in a 66-75 road win over Efes in December 2011.
- · Real Madrid big man Trey Thompkins set a career-high with 3 blocks playing for Nizhny Novgorod against Efes in November 2014.
- Efes center Bryant Dunston was named the 2013-14 EuroLeague Playoffs Game 3 MVP when he played for Olympiacos Piraeus against Real Madrid. He set a career-high with 21 points and added 9 rebounds and 4 assists for a performance index rating of 32.
- · Efes forward James Anderson matched his career-high with 3 steals playing for Darussafaka Istanbul against Real in February 2017.
- · Efes forward Adrien Moerman recorded a career-high in index rating of 33 against Real in December 2018.
- Real guard Alberto Abalde dished a career-high 8 assists playing for Valencia Basket against Efes in February 2018. He set a career-high with 3 steals for Valencia against Efes in October 2019.

# Game notes: Zenit St Petersburg vs FC Barcelona

Zenit St Petersburg vs. FC Barcelona

- · FC Barcelona held off Zenit 70-78 on Wednesday to take a 2-1 lead in the teams' best-of-five EuroLeague Playoffs series. Brandon Davies led all scorers with 22 points, 8 rebounds and 2 blocks in Barcelona's win.
- · Game 2 was an overtime thriller that went down to the wire, with Barcelona bouncing back from a loss in the series opener to down Zenit 81-78. Brandon Davies led the winners with 22 points and Kevin Pangos had 23 for Zenit.
- · Zenit held off Barcelona 74-76 for a road win in Game 1, which was the club's EuroLeague Playoffs debut. Kevin Pangos scored the winning basket with 10.7 seconds to go and paced Zenit with 19 points and 9 assists in a historic victory, the first by an eighth seed over a first seed in a playoffs opener.
- · The two teams split their regular-season series. In Round 2, Zenit edged Barcelona 74-70 with Alex Poythress collecting 16 points plus 11 rebounds. Billy Baron also scored 16 points. In Round 22, Barcelona held on for an 85-81 win as Brandon Davies scored
- · Barcelona swept Zenit last season, including a 90-72 win on its home floor. Kyle Kuric netted 21 points in that game.
- · Zenit played its first-ever EuroLeague home game against Barcelona last season. Barcelona raced to a 63-87 win behind 24 points from Kyle Kuric.
- · Barcelona's Victor Claver was a teammate of Zenit forward Andrey Zubkov during the 2015-16 season at Lokomotiv Kuban Krasnodar. They helped Lokomotiv reach the EuroLeague Final Four.

Vladimir Lucic was the home team's main inspiration, pairing a career-best 27 points with 7 rebounds.
- · In Game 1 of this series, Milan pulled out a dramatic 79-78 win on a buzzer-beating alley-oop layup by Zach LeDay, who led the winners with 17 points and 7 rebounds in that game. In Game 2, Milan beat Bayern 80-69 with Kevin Punter scoring 20 points.
- $\cdot$  Milan has a 7-4 edge in head-to-head games against Bayern, all played since October 2014. Before Bayern's Game 3 victory, Milan had won five consecutive games.
- $\cdot$  Milan swept Bayern in the regular season, which included a 75-51 home win in January. Milan held Bayern to club-record lows with 51 points, 2 three-pointers made, and a team PIR of 32.
- · In their season opener, Milan pulled out a 79-81 overtime win in Munich behind 17 points and 8 assists from Malcolm Delaney.
