# Game notes: Anadolu Efes Istanbul vs FC Barcelona

- Barcelona leads Efes 14-12 in games between them this century after a regular season sweep last season. Last year in Istanbul, Barcelona pulled out a 93-95 overtime win behind a career-high 24 points from Sertac Sanli.

- The last time they met, Barcelona edged Efes 82-77 on its home floor with Rokas Jokubaitis scoring 16 points.

- In the 2021 championship game, Efes beat Barcelona 86-81 to capture its first EuroLeague crown.

- Efes edged Barcelona 3-2 in their best-of-five EuroLeague Playoffs series in 2019.

- Barcelona set its club scoring mark in a EuroLeague road game and set a club record in threepointers made with 19 when it beat Efes 83-107 in Istanbul in March 2018.

- Barcelona's single-game individual record for PIR is 40, which Ante Tomic set against Efes in February 2014. In that game, Tomic also tied the club record with 11 two-point shots made.

- Efes recorded its team record in two-point shots made with 32 against Barcelona in October 2002.

- The EuroLeague single-game record for two-pointers made is 18, which Kaspars Kambala set with Efes against FC Barcelona in October 2002.

- Sertac Sanli joined Barcelona from Efes in the summer of 2021 after spending three seasons with Efes and helping the team win the 2021 EuroLeague title.

- Sanli has played alongside Dogus Balbay and Shane Larkin on the Turkish national team, too.

- Egehan Arna was a teammate of Barcelona's Jan Vesely and Nikola Kalinic at Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul from 2015 to 2019. Together they won the 2017 EuroLeague crown and reached the Final Four in each of the four seasons.

- Vesely was a teammate of Efes forward Achille Polonara at Fenerbahce last season.

- Efes center Tibor Pleiss played at Barcelona during the 2014-15 season. He was a teammate of current Barca guards Alex Abrines and Tomas Satoransky.

- Barcelona guard Nicolas Laprovittola was a teammate of Efes guards Rodrigue Beaubois and Shane Larkin during the second part of the 2016-17 season at Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz.

- Efes point guard Vasilije Micic played under Barcelona head coach Sarunas Jasikevicius at Zalgiris Kaunas during the 2017-18 season. They reached the 2018 Final Four together.

- Micic and Kalinic have been teammates on the Serbian national team.

- The last time Efes won in Barcelona, 86-88 in February 2021, Micic paced Efes with 26 points and 5 assists to earn the weekly co-MVP award.

- Micic was the EuroLeague MVP for Game 1 of the 2019 playoffs after posting a PIR of 30 when Efes beat Barcelona 75-68. He scored 21 points on 4-of-5 three-point shooting and dished 7 assists in that game.



# Game notes: Anadolu Efes Istanbul vs FC Barcelona

- Shane Larkin has had five weekly MVP performances against Barcelona. In Round 18 in the 2019-20 season, Efes pulled out an 82-86 road with Larkin collecting 26 points, 5 assists and 2 steals and for a performance index rating of 35. It was also the first of Larkin's unprecedented four consecutive MVP of the Round honors.

- Larkin earned MVP of the Round honors in Round 25 of the 2018-19 season after scoring 37 points and accumulating a PIR of 43 in a 92-70 home win over Barcelona. He was also MVP of Games 3 and 5 of the 2019 playoffs against Barcelona. Larkin scored 30 points on 6-of-7 three-point shooting in just 24 minutes for a PIR of 34 in Game 3 and had 18 points on 5-of-11 three-point shooting plus 7 assists for a PIR of 19 in Game 5.

- In December 2020, when Efes won 86-79 in Istanbul, Larkin posted 23 points, 8 assists, 7 rebounds, 2 steals and 9 drawn fouls for a performance index rating of 37 and earning weekly MVP honors.

- Larkin matched his career-high in steals with 4 playing for Baskonia against Barcelona in January 2017.

- Rokas Jokubaitis scored a career-high 16 points in a home win against Efes last season.

- Barcelona guard Nicolas Laprovittola matched his career-high with 10 assists playing for Real Madrid against Efes in Game 2 of their best-of-five playoff series last season.

- Efes center Ante Zizic had career-highs in points (24), PIR (33) and two-pointers made (12) playing for Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv against Barcelona in March 2021.

- Efes center Ante Zizic set his career high with 11 defensive rebounds playing for Darussafaka Istanbul against Barcelona in March 2017.

- Barcelona big man Jan Vesely set his career-high in PIR with 36 playing for Fenerbahce against Efes in October 2018.

- Barcelona center Mike Tobey posted his career highs with 21 points and PIR 27 playing for Valencia Basket against Efes in December 2020.



# Game notes: Partizan Mozzart Bet Belgrade vs Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv

- Partizan and Maccabi are tied at 6-6 in their EuroLeague games this century. This is their first meeting since March 2014. Home teams have won 10 of those 12 games.

The only time Maccabi beat Partizan in Belgrade was a 54-67 victory in November 2010.

- Partizan beat Maccabi 3-1 in their best-of-five 2010 EuroLeague playoff series. In Game 1, Partizan beat Maccabi 77-85 in Tel Aviv behind a club-record 7 three-pointers from Dusan Kecman. That is still the lone road win for Partizan against Maccabi.

- James Nunnally played for Maccabi last season. He helped the team reach the EuroLeague playoffs and was a teammate of John Dibartolomeo, Iftah Ziv, Roman Sorkin and Jake Cohen.

- Mathias Lessort also played for Maccabi in the first part of the last season.

- Partizan's Kevin Punter and Maccabi's Wade Baldwin were backcourt mates at Olympiacos during the 2019-20 season.

- Partizan forward Zach Leday had a career-high 4 blocks playing for Zalgiris Kaunas against Maccabi in January 2020.

- Partizan guard Dante Exum dished a career-high 7 assists playing for FC Barcelona against Maccabi in April of last season.

- Maccabi's Guy Pnini had a career-high 3 steals against Partizan in March 2010, and a career-best 6 rebounds in January 2014.

- Partizan guard Yam Madar was a teammate of Maccabi players Jake Cohen, Guy Pnini and Roman Sorkin on the Israeli national team over the summer at EuroBasket 2022.
