John Brown set the all-time single-season record with 69 steals last season.

Donatas Motiejunas set a EuroLeague single-game record with 18 defensive rebounds on December 7, 2011, playing for Asseco Prokom Gdynia against Union Olimpija Ljubljana. In that game, Motiejunas pulled down a total of 21 rebounds, the most rebounds in a single game by any active player.

Mike James ranks 15th in playoff history in scoring with 278 points. Kostas Sloukas of Olympiacos Piraeus is 14th with 282 and counting.

Mike James is fourth all-time with 3,848 points scored. Juan Carlos Navarro is third with 4,152.

James ranks fifth all-time in free throws made with 833. Juan Carlos Navarro is fourth with 853.

James is ranked 10th all-time with 1,072 career assists. Vasilije Micic of Anadolu Efes Istanbul is ninth with 1,097.

James ranks 10th all-time with 439 career three-pointers. Alexey Shved is ninth with 459.

James is in seventh place all-time with 3,893 index rating points. Kostas Sloukas is sixth with 3,955.



- Monaco beat Maccabi 86-74 in Game 2 behind Jordan Loyd who scored a career-best 33 points on a career-high 5-of-9 shooting from three-point range. He tallied a PIR of 36 to earn MVP of the Round honors.

- Maccabi downed Monaco 67-79 in Game 1 behind 20 points, 6 assists and 6 rebounds from Wade Baldwin. It is the only road win in six games between these two teams.

- Maccabi and Monaco split home wins in the regular season. In Round 3, Maccabi beat Monaco 78-70 with Wade Baldwin scoring 21 points. In Round 26, Maccabi beat Monaco 86-67 as Donta Hall collected 12 points and 10 rebounds.

- Maccabi and Monaco played their first official meetings last season and split home wins.

- Last season in Monaco, the hosts beat Maccabi 82-76 with Alpha Diallo and Mike James scoring 16 points apiece.

- Monaco forward John Brown and Maccabi playmaker Lorenzo Brown were teammates at UNICS Kazan last season.

- Maccabi big man Alex Poythress and Monaco guard Jordan Loyd were teammates at Zenit St Petersburg last season.

- Maccabi's Darrun Hilliard and Monaco's Mike James were teammates at CSKA Moscow for two seasons, from 2019 to 2021.

- Maccabi's Roman Sorkin posted his career high in rebounds - which he has since tied - with 9 in the Round 3 win over Monaco.

- Monaco big man Donta Hall had a career-high 4 blocks in the Round 3 loss against Maccabi.

- Hall had personal bests of 18 points and a PIR of 29 in a loss against Maccabi in November 2021.

Llull ranks second all-time with a 2.8-to-1 career assist-to-turnover ratio, Nigel Williams-Goss is 12th at 2.5-to-1 and Rudy Fernandez is 19th at 2.4-to-1.

Llull is in second place all-time with 577 three-point shots made; Fernandez is third with 569, and Rodriguez fourth with 568 threes. Juan Carlos Navarro is the all-time leader with 623.

Fernandez is ranked third all-time with 343 steals. Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is second with 406 and counting.

Fernandez needs 53 points to reach 3,000 for his career.

Rodriguez is in eighth place all-time with 289 career steals. Jan Vesely of FC Barcelona is seventh with 298 and counting.

Game notes: Partizan Mozzart Bet Belgrade vs Real Madrid

- Partizan leads the series 2-0 after an 80-95 win in Game 2, which was stopped with 1:40 to go in the fourth quarter after an on-court altercation that left both teams without the required minimum of two players each required to finish the game. Dante Exum scored 19 points and James Nunnally 16 for Partizan in the win.

- Partizan won the series opener 87-89 on a game-winning triple by Kevin Punter with 0.4 seconds to go. Punter netted 26 points on 5-for-8 three-point shooting and 6 assists, all new playoff highs. He earned MVP of the Round honor, tying his career best with a PIR of 33.

- Prior to this series and Partizan's two wins in Madrid, Real was 9-0 at home against Partizan this century and 11-0 all-time dating back to 1979.

- Real has won 15 of 20 games against Partizan this century; the teams split home wins during the regular season.

- In Round 10 in Madrid, Real beat Partizan 105-97. In that game, Partizan took the first quarter 32-40. The 72 combined points set a record for most points in a first quarter and the second most in any quarter of a EuroLeague game.

- When they played in Belgrade, in Round 32, Partizan beat Real 104-90 behind 16 points and 8 rebounds from Mathias Lessort. It is the only time Los Blancos allowed 100 or more points in a road game since January 2020.

- Coach Zeljko Obradovic led Real Madrid to the EuroLeague title in 1995. That was the eighth continental crown for Real and the third as head coach for Obradovic. He was Real Madrid's head coach for three seasons, from 1994 to 1997.

- Partizan forward Tristan Vukcevic joined Real Madrid as a teenager and made his professional debut there before joining Partizan in the middle of last season.

- Partizan guard Kevin Punter and forward Zach LeDay were teammates with Real point guard Sergio Rodriguez at EA7 Emporio Armani Milan during the 2020-21 season. They helped the team reach the 2021 Final Four.

- LeDay and Real guard Nigel Williams-Goss were teammates at Olympiacos Piraeus during the 2018-19 season.

- Williams-Goss played for Partizan during the 2017-18 season; he made his European debut with the club.

- Partizan center Mathias Lessort and Real center Vincent Poirier have been teammates on the French national team. Together they won bronze medals at the 2019 FIBA World Cup.

- Real forward Mario Hezonja and his Partizan counterpart Ioannis Papapetrou were teammates at Panathinaikos Athens in the second part of the 2020-21 season.

- Gabriel Deck tied his career high in PIR with 33 in Game 1 of this series.

- Partizan forward Zach Leday dished a career-high 6 assists in Round 10 against Real Madrid.

Moustapha Fall is the all-time leader in two-point accuracy at 71.8%.

Kostas Sloukas is ranked fourth all-time with 1,486 assists. Former teammate Vassilis Spanoulis is third with 1,607.

Sloukas ranks sixth all-time with 790 free throws made. Mike James of AS Monaco is fifth with 833 and counting.

Sloukas is ranked 11th all-time with 3,200 career points. His former teammate, Kyle Hines of EA7 Emporio Armani Milan is 10th with 3,226.

Sloukas is ranked sixth all-time with 3,955 index rating points. Paulius Jankunas is fifth with 4,067.

Sloukas ranks 12th all-time in free throw accuracy at 89.2%.

Kostas Papanikolaou is third all-time with 272 career starts; Nick Calathes of Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul is second with 273 and counting.

Papanikolaou is in 11th place all-time with 269 steals. His former teammate Vassilis Spanoulis is 10th with 273.

Papanikolaou needs 11 assists to reach 500 for his career.

Alec Peters ranks 20th all-time in three-point accuracy at 42.9%.

Canaan needs 14 points to reach 500 for his career.



Game notes: Fenerbahce Beko Istanbul vs Olympiacos Piraeus

- Olympiacos and Fenerbahce are tied at 14-14 in head-to-head games played this century after Fenerbahce came from 16 points down to edge Olympiacos 78-82 in Game 2. Carsen Edwards scored 16 points and Nigel Hayes-Davis had 15 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists to lead Fenerbahce.

- In Game 1, Olympiacos registered a 79-68 victory, setting a club playoff record with 16 threepointers. Leading the way was Isaiah Canaan on career-best 6-for-7 shooting from downtown for 18 points, while Sasha Vezenkov scored 19.

- The Reds swept their regular season series against Fenerbahce. In Round 13, Olympiacos thrashed Fenerbahce 94-67 behind 21 points from Sasha Vezenkov. In Round 22, the Reds beat Fenerbahce 72-93 behind 21 points from Kostas Papanikolaou, 20 points from Isaiah Canaan and 12 points plus 12 rebounds from Vezenkov.

- This is a rematch of the 2017 Turkish Airlines EuroLeague Championship Game, which Fenerbahce 80-64 in Istanbul.

- Fenerbahce matched its club record with 9 blocked shots against Olympiacos in the 2017 championship game.

- Kostas Sloukas spent five seasons with Fenerbahce, from 2015 to 2020. He helped the club win the 2017 EuroLeague, reach four Final Fours and win three Turkish League championships in his time there.

- Sloukas, Kostas Papanikolaou, Michalis Lountzis and Giannoulis Larentzakis have played under Fenerbahce head coach Dimitris Itoudis and have been teammates of Fenerbahce guards Nick Calathes and Tyler Dorsey and center Kostas Antetokounmpo on the Greek national team.

- Fenerbahce guard Tyler Dorsey played for Olympiacos last season and helped it reach the 2022 Final Four. Dorsey has also been a teammate of Kostas Papanikolaou, Giannoulis Larentzakis, Kostas Sloukas and Michalis Lountzis on the Greek national team.

- Sloukas had a career-best 4 steals in a road loss against Fenerbahce in January 2022.

- Olympiacos guard Thomas Walkup was a teammate of Fenerbahce's Nigel Hayes-Davis at Zalgiris Kaunas for two seasons, from 2019 to 2021.

- Olympiacos forward Alec Peters helped CSKA win the 2018-19 EuroLeague playing under Coach Itoudis.

- Peters had career-highs in points (25) and PIR (31) playing for Baskonia Vitoria-Gasteiz against Fenerbahce in November 2020.

- Olympiacos guard Isaiah Canaan and Fenerbahce center Tonye Jekiri were teammates at UNICS Kazan last season.

- In Round 22 in Istanbul, Canaan made a career-best 6 triples on 9 attempts in the Reds' 20-point win over Fenerbahce. He matched the mark for three-pointers made in Game 1 when he shot 6-of-7 from behind the arc.



- Fenerbahce center Kostas Antetokounmpo posted his career high with 7 rebounds in a Round 22 home loss against Olympiacos.

- Olympiacos center Tarik Black had some of his best performances against Fenerbahce. He posted career-highs in points (23), two-pointers made (10) and PIR (28) playing for Maccabi Tel Aviv against Fenerbahce in April 2019. He also had a career-best 15 rebounds, including 7 offensive rebounds, playing for Maccabi against Fenerbahce in October 2019.

- Olympiacos forward Kostas Papanikolaou dished a career-high 6 assists against Fenerbahce in November 2017.

- Fenerbahce point guard Nick Calathes posted his career high in rebounds with 13 playing for FC Barcelona against Olympiacos in October 2021.

- Fenerbahce guard Scottie Wilbekin made a career-high 12 free throws playing for Maccabi Playtika Tel Aviv against Olympiacos in January 2021.
