Mike James is fourth all-time with 3,920 points scored. Juan Carlos Navarro is third with 4,152.

James moved into fourth place all-time in free throws made with 855. Felipe Reyes is third with 967.

James is ranked 10th all-time with 1,085 career assists. Vasilije Micic of Anadolu Efes Istanbul is ninth with 1,097.

James ranks 10th all-time with 447 career three-pointers. Alexey Shved is ninth with 459.

James is in seventh place all-time with 3,960 index rating points. Kostas Sloukas of Olympiacos Piraeus is sixth with 4,033 and counting.

Game notes: AS Monaco vs FC Barcelona

- Barcelona has won all four of its games against Monaco so far, including a regular season sweep this season.
- Barcelona pulled out a 63-69 victory in Round 13 behind 15 points plus 9 rebounds from Nikola Mirotic and won 80-70 at home in Round 25 with Tomas Satoransky scoring 15 points.
- The two teams met for the first time last season and Barcelona swept their regular-season series, including an 81-85 overtime win in Monaco and an 88-83 home win.
- Monaco's Jordan Loyd and Barcelona big man Mike Tobey were teammates at Valencia Basket during the 2019-20 season.
- Monaco's Donatas Motiejunas and Barcelona's Rokas Jokubaitis have been teammates on the Lithuanian national team.
- Monaco big man John Brown scored a career-high 21 points playing for UNICS Kazan against Barcelona in December 2021. Brown also had a career-high 7 steals against Barcelona in their second clash last season, in January 2022.

- Real holds a 19-17 edge in their meetings since the turn of the century, but Olympiacos swept their regular season series. This will be their fourth EuroLeague championship game.
- In their last meeting, Olympiacos beat Real 73-60 in Greece with Thomas Walkup scoring his season-high 18 points.
- In Round 3, Olympiacos edged Real in Madrid 87-89 with Sasha Vezenkov collecting a double-double of 23 points and 12 rebounds.
- Real Madrid downed Olympiacos in the 1995 EuroLeague championship game, 73-61. Arvydas Sabonis was chosen as the 1995 Final Four MVP.
- Olympiacos defeated Real Madrid 100-89 for the 2013 EuroLeague title in London. Vassilis Spanoulis scored 22 points in that game and was named Final Four MVP.
- Real Madrid routed Olympiacos 78-59 in the 2015 Turkish Airlines EuroLeague Championship Game in the Spanish capital. Jaycee Carroll led a balanced Madrid attack with 16 points on 4-of-5 three-point shooting and Andres Nocioni was named Final Four MVP.
- Olympiacos and Real Madrid have faced each other three times in the EuroLeague Playoffs. Real advanced to the Final Four in 1996 with a 2-1 win in the best-of-three series and Olympiacos ousted Real 3-1 in 2009's best-of-five series. Real eliminated Olympiacos in the 2014 EuroLeague Playoffs 3-2. Rudy Fernandez led Los Blancos with an average of 17.2 points and 5.6 rebounds per game and Sergio Llull starred with 20 points in the decisive fifth game.
- Real's single-game club record in scoring is 33 points, which Luka Doncic set against Olympiacos on December 8, 2017.
- Real's Sergio Rodriguez and Baskonia forward Alec Peters were teammates at CSKA Moscow during the 2018-19 season. They helped the team win the EuroLeague title.
- Real guard Nigel Williams-Goss made his EuroLeague debut playing with Olympiacos Piraeus in the 2018-19 season. He was a teammate of Sasha Vezenkov and Kostas Papanikolaou.

- Fall set his career-high with 11 rebounds and 5 blocked shots playing for LDLC ASVEL Villeurbanne against Real in March 2021.
- Real swingman Mario Hezonja and Olympiacos forward Kostas Papanikolaou were teammates at FC Barcelona during the 2013-14 season.
- Olympiacos guard Isaiah Canaan and Hezonja were teammates at UNICS Kazan last season.
- Hezonja posted his career high with 4 steals playing for UNICS Kazan against Olympiacos last season.
